Those interested in taking the TASC Exam at EOC

1. Fill out a TASC application with a Counselor (located on the 3rd floor) A COMPLETE Application includes:
 - a. HSE/TASC Boot Camp Completion (EOC only)
 - b. HSE/TASC Readiness Practice Scores (for new testers) or Official NYS TASC/GED Transcript (for re-testers)
 - c. Picture I.D.
 - d. Additional information (if under age 19; Attachments B, D, E, or F)
 - e. T-TAF form (if referred from a preparation site, including EOC)

2. Choose two test dates (1st choice month and 2nd choice month; SPACE IS LIMITED)
