

2015 INTERNATIONAL APPLICANT FINANCIAL FORM – UNDERGRADUATE

Applicants must *document* the full cost of *only the first year of study* before the university can issue a Certificate of Visa Eligibility (Form I-20 or DS-2019).

¹Tuition indicated above is the anticipated 2015-16 tuition rate for the academic year only (September–May). Tuition and fees are subject to change. Tuition can increase annually (but doesn't always). The above tuition is for Fall and Spring semesters and is based on the "flat tuition" model where the cost is the same for 12 or more credits (it is not per credit). Summer and Winter session tuition and fees are not included above; Summer and Winter sessions; students are not required to study in the summer and winter sessions; Summer and Winter tuition is charged per credit; undergraduate tuition and fees are approximately \$1,077 per credit hour.

²Health insurance fee is for the full 12-month year.

All documents submitted to UB become the property of UB; they cannot be returned or forwarded to another person/institution.

³This includes housing and food costs for the Fall and Spring semesters (one academic year); optional Summer and Winter sessions and school breaks are not included (if the student were to live on campus in those periods). The university estimates that students will need an additional \$1,500 for books and supplies, and \$1,500 for personal expenses and incidental costs.
