## SCHOLARSHIPS

**Up to 100% tuition**

All students applying to enroll as freshmen in the fall semester are considered for International Admissions Scholarships. No separate application is necessary. Awards typically range from \$1,000 to \$15,000 and are given to those with the best academic records. Submission of SAT/ACT scores is highly recommended.

Admission is based on the applicant's academic records:

### 1 SCHOOL MARKS (GPA)

**Freshman:** B average, 3.0/4.0 GPA (or equivalent)  
**Transfer:** C+ average, 2.5/4.0 GPA (or equivalent)

### 2 RIGOR OF SCHOOL CURRICULUM

### 3 PREPAREDNESS FOR UNIVERSITY STUDY

### 4 TEST SCORES (SAT/ACT)

**Freshman:** Required for direct admission to certain majors; otherwise optional.  
**Transfer:** Not required
