4 WNY colleges win workplace honors

Four Western New York universities have qualified for the national list of "Great Colleges to Work For," as complied by the **Chronicle of Higher Education**.

Canisius College, Niagara University, SUNY Fredonia and the **University at Buffalo** are among the 97 universities being recognized nationwide.

The weekly newspaper released the list on Monday morning.

Colleges were rated in 12 categories deemed to be of key importance to employees, based on a survey of 43,000 professors, administrators and staffers at 275 universities across the country.

Niagara University, which was highly rated in 11 of 12 categories, was named to the Chronicle's Honor Roll, the highest distinction in the study. Thirty universities were chosen for the Honor Roll.

Canisius, SUNY Fredonia and UB were also recognized for excellence in at least one of the designated categories.
