

Stenborg and Henderson Receive Equity's Richard Seff Award

Helen Stenborg and Stephen McKinley Henderson have been named to receive the annual Richard Seff Award presented by the Actors' Equity Foundation. The award, a \$1,000 check and crystal trophy for each, honors

a veteran female and male character actor for the best performance in a supporting role in a Broadway or Off-Broadway production.

Helen Stenborg was cited for her performance in the two-hander, VIGIL, presented at Off-Broadway's DR2 Theatre. Previously Ms.
Stenborg appeared on Broadway in WAITING IN THE WINGS, for which she received a Tony nomination; THE CRUCIBLE; A MONTH IN THE COUNTRY; and A LIFE. She and her late husband, Barnard Hughes (the recipient of Equity's St. Clair Bayfield Award in 1973), toured the country in Da, and received Lifetime Achievement Awards from the Drama Desk in 2000. Ms. Stenborg also has appeared Off-



Broadway, in films, on TV and for 16 seasons was at the O'Neill Playwrights Conference.

Stephen McKinley Henderson was recognized for his performance in the Broadway revival of August Wilson's FENCES. Other Broadway credits include August Wilson's KING HEDLEY II and the revival of Ma Rainey'S BLACK BOTTOM; DRACULA AND DROWNING CROW. He was also a member of Mr. Wilson'S JITNEY ensemble, which received a 2002 Olivier Award for Outstanding Drama. He has appeared at The Public Theatre, Yale Rep, the Signature Theatre and the Kennedy Center. Professor and former chair of the Department of Theatre and Dance at SUNY Buffalo, he is a member of the LAByrinth Theatre Company, the Actor's Center and is a Fox Foundation Fellow.

Equity member <u>Richard Seff</u> established this award in 2003.
