Governor Joined by Higher **Education Officials to Push for SUNY Reforms**

Governor David Paterson was joined by public higher education leaders in Albany Tuesday to push for passage of a bill that would give the State University of New York more flexibility.

The Public Higher Education Empowerment and Innovation Act has languished in the State Legislature since its was first introduced a few months ago. The reforms would give SUNY more authority over setting tuition, allow for more public-private partnerships and relieve some of the Governor's Deregulation Plan But Opposes Proposed Spending Cuts obstacles in procurements.

"The best way to connect education with economic development is to have all kinds of links between the two," Paterson said. "We can't do this under the current system. We need reform"

University at Buffalo President John Simpson says he needs the flexibility this bill would provide to fully implement his UB 2020 plan. Simpson was among the education leaders who spoke in support of the bill yesterday. He says Western New Yorkers are fully behind the proposed reforms.
