Buffalo gets \$900,000 toward treatment plans

BUFFALO, N.Y. — The University at Buffalo has received \$900,000 in federal funds to develop ways to train doctors to treat addicted patients.
Dr. Richard Blondell is director of addictions research and a professor of family medicine at UB. He says there's a shortage of doctors qualified to conduct clinical research on addictions and to translate research into practice.
The funding from the National Institute on Alcoholism and Alcohol Abuse will fund a council of professionals who will develop curricula for graduate medical education programs in addiction medicine. The goal is for the programs to be used in medical schools around the country.
