Undergraduate intended majors are attributed to majors in which they have declared interest. Matriculated undecided majors are assigned to "Undergraduate Education". Non-matriculated Undergraduate Non Degree students are attributed to "Provost Enrollment". UUP students are assigned to "Other Independent Entities". Provisional Graduate students are assigned to "Graduate Education". MFC plans are attributed to "Educational Collaboration and Engagement". "Undetermined" unit assignments result from non-standard coding generated by new student and SUNYIR systems at respective go-lives. Regular Enrollment: enrollments that will exist within the framework of the negotiated enrollment plan between UB and SUNY and funded by State tax appropriation and income prescribed from a tuition price specified in State education Law that is charged to and collected from UB students under the auspices of the university's enrollment plan. These enrollments generate state tax funding. Externally Funded Enrollment: enrollments generated as the result of special contractual arrangements (contract course or sponsored program contract, e.g., Singapore) between the university and a third-party entity to deliver educational services to targeted and defined populations envisioned to be benefited by that contract. The policies governing the university entering into these contracts allow the university to charge a tuition rate that covers all costs (direct and indirect) of delivering these educational programs. Therefore, there is no expectation that these enrollments will generate State tax funding. These enrollments exist outside of the framework of the negotiated enrollment plan between UB and SUNY and funded by State tax appropriation and income from a prescribed tuition price specified in State Education Law that is charged to and collected from UB students under the auspices of the university's enrollment plan.
