

HOW TO OBTAIN ACCESS TO SIRI STUDENT REPORTS

In order to obtain access to SIRI Student Reports, you will need access to a computer and a connection to the internet.

- 1) Point your browser to the InfoSource Request Access page located at:
https://isonline.buffalo.edu/infosource/general_info/signup/reqaccess.html
- 2) Scan down the page to the “Student Records” section. Complete the survey located at:
<https://vovici.com/wsb.dll/s/8727g4a2f5>.
- 3) Send an email to HUB-SR-ACCESS-LIST@listserv.buffalo.edu indicating that you have completed the survey. You can do this easily by clicking the “Office of the Registrar” link. That will open up an e-mail box. Type a message indicating that you have completed the *Student Records Data Access Survey* and that you would like access to *SIRI Student Reports*.
- 4) Log on to SIRI to activate your account. You log on using your UBIT name and password, and the SIRI web address is <https://siri.buffalo.edu>. Complete login and navigation instructions are included in the [SIRI Users Guide for Student Dashboard](#), located at:

- 5) Once approval is obtained from the Registrar, your request will be forwarded to Donna Czaja in Business Services (SIRI Trustee), for processing. Donna will contact you once your *SIRI Student Reports* access is established.
