School-Age Summer Program



UBCCC's Summer Program for school-age children (5-12 years) continues to be housed **only at our South Campus location.** Cathy Smith (cs236@buffalo.edu), SC Program Coordinator and Catherine Turner (School-Age Teacher) have already been working hard to plan this year's weekly field trips! As in previous years, the children will also swim twice a week at Clark Hall. The center is excited to announce that it is able to extend the number of weeks available to **10 weeks** (through 9/1/17), and will require a 6-week minimum enrollment. Part-time (M/W/F or T/Th) spots are also available on a limited basis. Mixed-Age Classrooms

Beginning this Fall 2017 semester, UBCCC North will introduce a new Preschool programming. Called "Mixed-Age Classrooms", each of the North center's four preschool rooms will house children aged 3, 4 and 5 years old enrolled in it.

Per the center email sent out to UBCCC families on Friday, February 24th, the toddlers moving into the Preschool program will stay with the same teacher until they leave the center to attend Kindergarten, giving children and parents the opportunity to build stronger relationships with the teachers. This fall, the currently enrolled preschool children will be assigned to one of the four rooms. Each room will be enrolled with the goal of balancing the ages among the four classrooms.



At this time, UBCCC South will keep the preschool program it currently has, with the integrated preschool in collaboration with BornHava, and the PK classroom.

UBCCC has chosen to adopt this philosophy of early childhood care and education based on research that shows how interactions with older and younger children benefit the social and emotional development of preschool children.

Younger children learn from the advanced growth and development of the older children. Older children have the opportunity to be role models for the younger children, which builds their confidence and leadership skills in preparation for moving on to Kindergarten.

This program change is another way the center hopes to further enhance our children's' experience and fulfill its mission of providing high quality, developmentally appropriate care to the young children in our community.
