 - How do we help our society? Focus on the greater good
 - What are we doing to enhance student transfer? Some active work is happening, more to follow.
- Provost's Report
 - o 30% decline in transfers over the last 5 years
 - Embedding UB counselors in Community Colleges
 - Allowing Community Colleges to table at UB events

- o What programs are students choosing over us?
 - Unknown. Low response rate on surveys
- o Is there a decline happening in High Schools?
 - Yes, less people are going to college
- o Are we meeting our enrollment outcomes?
 - Provost would like to present on student success next month to answer this more fully.
- If this declining trend in undergraduate enrollment continues when will the revenue effect our planning?
 - We are growing in masters' programs (off set)
 - International enrollment is declining, this is a challenge
- o What time of the year is the budget made? How does enrollment/tuition effect this?
 - Today's enrollment effects the budget this year and going forward
 - Gap is hard to fill
 - 2/3 operating revenue from tuition
 - 1/3 from state taxes (we are well supported by NYS)
- Chair's Report
 - o Faculty satisfaction survey item regarding lengthening appointment renewals, three options:
 - #1 Go to UUP with issue for next contract
 - #2 Create a carve-out at UB, with UUP approval
 - #3 UB/SUNY Senate action to the Board of Trustees
 - FSEC discussion supports #2 & #3
- Chair will send out an email to all faculty with a link to the Faculty Satisfaction Survey report given by Dr. Prinari to FS in October.
