- Provost's report accepted
 - Middle States Assessment Chair visited campus this month. Full team will arrive March 10-13 for site visit
 - Research is not a measurement of Middle States thus no questions or input in that area was required.
 - o Recruitment of diverse faculty
 - Goal for Top 25
 - VITAL program welcomed 35 scholars
 - Cutting edge research from underrepresented scholars
 - Potential faculty pipeline
 - First fall break was a success. Card swipe data shows students active on campus as programming was available for them.
 - President reported \$1 Billion goal was met 8 months ahead of schedule at his State of the University address
 - UB received a \$40 million gift from Russ Agrusa for SEAS
- Chair's report accepted
 - Comparing COACHE and Faculty Satisfaction Surveys to find common goals for Faculty Senate activities
 - UB Policy Handbook is under partial revision to address DEI
 - o October 4th Brooke Lerner passed away (moment of silence)

- 1st reading: Resolution to Adjust UBC Diversity in the United States Requirement Learning Outcomes by FS Academic Planning & Assessment Committee accepted
- <u>Faculty Satisfaction Committee Survey Results</u> accepted
 - Recommendations highlights:
 - The Budget Priorities Committee should propose a resolution for the creation of a shared-governance budget committee. Once the committee is constituted and faculty members appointed, the FSEC should invite designated members of the Administration and the Professional Staff to join them and commence this work. Full financial data will be crucial.
 - The Academic Tenure, Promotion, and Privileges Committee should make recommendations, propose resolutions and oversee processes
 - Review and resolutions by Budget Priorities Committee and Teaching and Learning Committee.
 - The FS Review Committee should make recommendations on how to improve the effectiveness of the FS. If changes to the bylaws are deemed necessary, the FS Bylaws committee should be involved.
 - The FSEC should work with UB senior leadership to ensure that the basic principles of shared governance are upheld, including in particular adequate involvement of the FS in major decisions that affect the faculty.
 - A new standing Survey Committee should be formed to review both the Administration and the Senate every three years. The FS ad-hoc committee for the Faculty Satisfaction with the Leadership Survey can propose a resolution for the creation of such a standing committee.
 - The Academic Planning Committee should review the data, and work with the FSEC to make recommendations/propose resolutions.
 - The Equity and Diversity Committee should record ongoing policies and results, make recommendations and report to the FS for deliberation/resolutions.
 - The Teaching and Learning Committee and the Information Technology Committee should make recommendations, propose resolutions and oversee this process.

Other Items

- Click system has become an issue for faculty to conduct timely research. What can the Faculty Senate do to assist?
 - November Faculty Senate meeting will have a presentation from the new Assistant VP for Sponsored Projects
- PhD students' tuition is charged to grants, this is unique among SUNYs
 - Recommendation to have Teaching & Learning, Academic Planning, and/or Promotion and Tenure committees address this issue.
