## UB FACULTY SENATE

- Representation of the Voting Faculty is through Faculty Senators and Campus Governance Leadership (CGL) including Chair of the Faculty Senate (FS) and Cynthia Tysick, as Secretary of the FS

## UB FACULTY SENATE

- Represents the "voting" Faculty (>1700, Article III: Full-time, unqualified academic rank, except instructors, and all full-time qualified academic rank with appointments > 1 yr )
- ~100 senators
- Annual elections, term is 2 yrs
- Faculty Senate meets once a month during academic yr.
- 1 Executive Committee, 13 Standing Committees, \& ad hoc committees as needed
- Powers and Duties include ("all things academic, " (Charter, Article II)):
- Vote on resolutions approved by FSEC
- FS Executive Committee is 'Committee on Committees' and oversees FS committees



## FACULTY SENATORS

## Duties \& Responsibilities

- Alternates - elected or appointed by senator
- Attendance - 8 meetings during academic year

1. Senator/alternate attends all meetings
2. Senator/alternate miss 3 unexplained absences, or 4 explained absences then membership may be terminated
3. Senators if unable to attend must notify alternates of meeting date/place/time

## FS VOTING FACULTY SHALL:

Initiate or Approve University Policies or Standards Regarding :

- Curriculum institution or changes
- Conduct and evaluation of academic research and teaching
- Appointment, promotion, and tenure of faculty
- Evaluation of student's academic work
- Admissions and degree-granting programs
- Graduation and awarding of academic degrees

Review Prior to Adoption Proposals Regarding:

- Formal plans for the future of the University
- Formation, reorganizing, dissolving academicunits
- Policies or standards governing speech and assembly on campuses
- Governance of academic units


## FS EXECUTIVE COMMITTEE

- Acts as the representative of the Senate to implement existing Senate policy
- Set the agenda for the Senate
- Submit reports on all its votes to Senate
- Establish ad hoc committees
- Receive reports from Senate committees



## FS EXECUTIVE COMMITTEE

- All faculty units are represented
- Meets $2 x$ per month during academic yr.
- FSEC members liaison with standing committees
- Standing Committees 13
- Scheduled Reports to FSEC


## RESPONSIBILITIES OF SENATE MEMBERS

- Attend FS Meetings: If quorums are not met, work is not done, your colleagues time is wasted
- VOTE on resolutions
- Report back to your academic units
- Report from your academic units report items for discussion to the Secretary of FS
- You are providing service to the university, your school, your department, our community


## SHARED GOVERNANCE

- Collaboration between faculty, staff, students, administration, unions and governing boards on issues of common concern and values
- Shared Governance is valued across all constituencies including SUNY Chancellors, SUNY Trustee's Chair, Campus Presidents, SUNY Faculty Senate (SUNY Voices) and Accreditation bodies (Middle States Association of Colleges and Universities)
- Emphasis on diversity (people, groups, ideas)
