

Fee Schedule for Hood use in Stem Cell Culture Facility (SCCF)

For accuracy of management and fairness to all users, we have implemented a single comprehensive fee schedule based on the number of hours of Hood Use by each user of the Facility. This comprehensive fee will include use of the hoods, standard CO2 incubators, all other equipment (centrifuges, water baths, etc) and the LN2 Dewar for storage of cell lines. Long term storage will be negotiated on a case-by-case basis. A separate fee will be charged for use of the Low O2 incubators as separate N2 tanks need to be ordered for their use. The comprehensive fee will cover the costs of CO2 tanks, LN2, hood certification, amortization of equipment costs and equipment replacement (hoods, incubators, vacuum pumps, centrifuges, pipet aids, etc.), hazardous waste disposal and any other costs associated with cell culture other than supplies and reagents. These will be provided by the users.

Only cell lines which are certified negative for mycoplasma may be used in the facility hoods and incubators. The facility reserves the right to refuse use of any cell lines not shown to be negative for mycoplasma in the facility hoods by an assay judged suitable by the facility.
