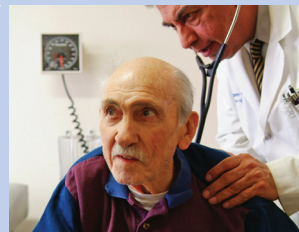

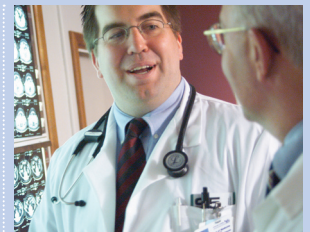
DEGREES OF LIFE
