Arts

The arts have had a long history at UB and the surrounding community. Today, the Center for the Arts is the heart of arts activity at UB. Home to hundreds of concerts and shows each year, the \$50 million center features four theaters, two dance studios, the UB Art Gallery, and a signature atrium.

VOLUMINOUS LIBRARY

Lockwood Library houses over 40,000 volumes on art related topics. The Poetry Collection and the Rare Books Collection contain over 90,000 volumes of twentieth-century poetry, as well as recordings, notebooks, letters, broadsides, manuscripts, magazines, and a number of prints, sculptures, paintings, and photographs.



CONCERTS IN SLEE HALL

Lippes Concert Hall in Slee Hall hosts concerts and recitals by guest artists, faculty, students, and ensembles, including the annual Beethoven String Quartet Cycle and the June in Buffalo festival.

BROWN BAG MUSIC

Throughout the year, the Brown Bag concert series offers free concerts during lunchtime in Lippes Concert Hall in Slee Hall, while showcasing the music departments varied talent.

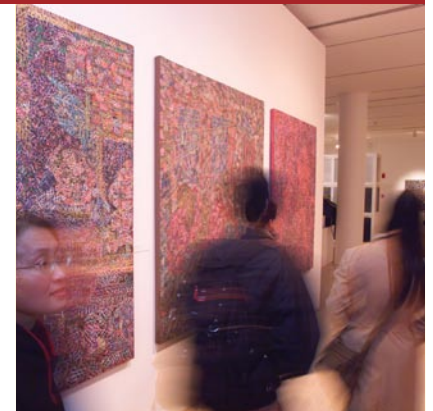

NEW MUSIC FESTIVAL

Since 1975, UB has been home to the world-renowned June in Buffalo festival of contemporary music. Notable composers involved in the festival have included Morton Feldman, Lukas Foss, John Cage, and David Felder.

Music Is Art Live @ The Center is a collaboration between the Center for the Arts and Music Is Art Foundation. Broadcast on Thinkbright-TV, the series features Western New York's best contemporary musicians and visual artists.



YOUTH ARTS PROGRAM

Explore the Arts is a theatrical arts summer program for children entering grades 5-8. UB professional staff, faculty, and area professionals teach the weeklong session, which is aimed at developing technical and performance skills in a creative environment.
