POSITIVE DECLARATION

The State University of New York (SUNY) on behalf of the University at Buffalo (UB) is undertaking a Comprehensive Physical Plan to guide the growth and development of the university in support of its plan for academic excellence. Preliminary concepts of the plan expand and enhance UB facilities at its three campuses, providing an additional 6.5 million square feet of floor space to accommodate an additional 10,000 students, 1,000 faculty, and 2,750 staff by the year 2030.

SUNY on behalf of UB, as Lead Agency, has determined that the proposed Type I Action has the potential for at least one negative environmental impact. SUNY/UB has made a Positive Declaration for this Action, and as such, shall cause to have a Generic Environmental Impact Statement (GEIS) prepared.

SUNY/UB will be soliciting comments on the Draft Scoping Document which will be available to the public on or by Monday January 19th, 2009. Copies of the Draft Scope of Work will be available at:
