

# The Power of Philanthropy in Higher Education

#### Philanthropy in Higher Education

Higher education institutions received **over \$61** billion from philanthropic giving in 2024 alone.


- Compared to the prior year, this increased by 3 percent when adjusted for inflation.
- As other sources of annual revenue decrease, this voluntary support—philanthropy—is vital to the long-term sustainability of U.S. colleges and universities.




#### **Philanthropy at UB**

Last year, the University received **over \$95 million** in committed dollars. Over the course of the Boldy Buffalo campaign, this has contributed towards:

- 976 new research funds
- 52 new endowed faculty positions
- Over \$781M has been raised for student success
- 100+ new or renovated state-of-the-art facilities or spaces
- 345 new scholarships, fellowships, and awards

This initiative represents more than a simple solicitation—it is a **long-term**, **strategic partnership** with prospects and donors built on **collaboration** and **shared vision**.

University Advancement is comprised of **over 120 dedicated professionals** focused on cultivating meaningful relationships and driving philanthropic growth. This includes not only gift officers, but also experts in prospect research and analytics, donor relations, stewardship, and more.

We work in close partnership with deans, faculty, and university leadership to align institutional priorities with donor interests, ensuring that every engagement is purposeful and impactful.





#### Making the Ask: How Frontline Fundraising Happens


This journey begins with relationship building and thoughtful **cultivation**, evolving through personalized outreach and meaningful engagement.

Affinity and identity-based programs—such as alumni networks and student groups—play a vital role in **deepening connections** and **fostering a sense of belonging**, creating pathways for lifelong engagement.

Crafting the ask is a strategic and collaborative process that formalizes gift agreements—defining purpose, use, and recognition—while ensuring donor intent **aligns with university priorities**.

# Receiving the Gift: UBF's Role as Fiduciary Steward

The UB Foundation plays a critical role in ensuring that every philanthropic gift is protected, responsibly managed, and aligned with **both legal standards** and **donor expectations**.

Upon receiving a gift, UBF issues IRS-compliant receipts and ensures that all legal acceptance policies are met—providing **confidence and transparency** for donors and campus partners alike.

Each fund is established with a clearly defined purpose—either current-use or endowed—based on the signed gift agreement, ensuring **alignment** with donor intent from the outset.



### Receiving the Gift: UBF's Role as Fiduciary Steward



Endowed assets are pooled and invested in accordance with NYPMIFA guidelines, generating a sustainable 4–5% annual payout that supports today's needs while preserving long-term principal.

UBF continuously monitors fund balances and expenditures to verify **compliance** with donor intent, proactively flagging any unspent or misused funds.

Regular financial **reports** are shared with campus units and Advancement, reinforcing stewardship and supporting meaningful donor engagement.

## Partnership in Action: The Campus Role in Fund Utilization




Once a gift is received and the fund is established, campus units become the key players in fulfilling donor intent. This may include awarding scholarships through AcademicWorks, funding research or academic programming, hiring faculty for endowed professorships, or launching capital projects such as buildings and labs.

Timely and appropriate spending is essential—not only to ensure impact but also to prevent stagnant balances, which can erode donor confidence and stewardship momentum.

### Partnership in Action: The Campus Role in Fund Utilization

While University Advancement and UBF provide guidance and oversight, campus partners are the implementers who **bring donor-funded initiatives to life**. Their role is critical in maintaining trust and delivering on philanthropic commitments.

Accurate tracking, transparent reporting, and close coordination with UBF and Advancement are essential for **long-term success** and **continued donor engagement**.

# Stewardship: Closing the Loop and Reinviting the Donor


