UB's commitment to big thinking is the key to attracting expert faculty who create a learning environment where you can thrive.

The **Solar Strand**, part of UB's climate action plan to reach net-zero emissions by 2030, generates clean, renewable electricity for the university. Over the past seven years, UB has generated or purchased 100% of its electricity from renewable sources, reducing its carbon footprint by about one-third from baseline levels. The Solar Strand, along with new solar arrays across the North Campus, can generate over 12 million kWh of solar energy—enough to power more than 1,750 homes or charge over 1 trillion smartphones—making UB one of the largest higher education on-site renewable energy producers in the country.
