Important Information

- UB is test optional and supports SUNY's decision to make the submission of SAT and ACT test scores optional for undergraduate admissions consideration. Students can share their scores as part of their application if they choose by selecting the corresponding option on their application. If submitting scores, SAT or ACT standardized test scores must be submitted directly from the testing agency. UB's SAT code is 2925. The ACT code is 2978. UB welcomes students from all backgrounds, and each application goes through the same holistic review process.
- Please be aware that there are two SUNY Buffalo institutions listed on both the Common Application and the ApplySUNY Application. Make sure to select the University at Buffalo when you complete your forms, or your application might go to the wrong school.
- UB requires your high school transcript or completion of your Self-Reported Transcript and Academic Record System (STARS). Your high school transcript can be uploaded or sent from your high school, and the STARS can be completed via the link in your UB Applicant Status Page.
- UB strongly recommends the submission of at least one letter of recommendation from a school counselor, teacher, community member or employer. You may choose to submit up to three letters.

Once you submit your application, you will receive an email with login credentials for your personalized **Applicant Status Page.** Here, you will be able to monitor your application status, checklist and other notifications.
