

# CTRC Hosts Biomedical Research Day for Student Trainees

Students who participated in 6 different summer research programs at UB, Roswell Park and the Hauptman Woodward Institute took part in a day-long program at the CTRC on August 2. In an enormously popular and successful event, the students presented their biomedical research projects in poster format and in oral presentations.

The program featured a total of 98 posters and 8 oral presentations by student trainees. Lively poster sessions afforded students the opportunity to present and their discuss their research with student colleagues and faculty.

The undergraduate and professional graduate students who participated were supported by 6 different programs:

- Summer Undergraduate Research Program (SURE) at the UB School of Medicine and Biomedical Sciences
- Student Research Program at the UB School of Dental Medicine
- Summer Research Experience Program in Cancer Science at Roswell Park Cancer Institute
- T35 Research Program in Infectious Diseases, Microbiology and Immunology at the UB School of Medicine and Biomedical Sciences and Roswell Park Cancer Institute
- Summer Apprentice Program at the Hauptman-Woodward Medical Research Institute
- Collaborative Learning and Integrated Mentoring in the Biosciences Undergraduate Program (CLIMB UP at UB), with several students funded by the Institute for the Strategic Enhancement of Educational Diversity (ISEED)

A highlight of the day was an insightful and entertaining talk by UB Provost Charles Zukoski about early influences as he began his long and productive career in research.
