Students who participated in 10 different summer research programs at University at Buffalo, Roswell Park Cancer Institute and the Hauptman Woodward Institute took part in a day-long program at the CTRC on August 1, 2014. In an enormously successful event, attended by ~120 people, the students presented their biomedical research projects in poster format and in oral presentations. The program featured a total of 97 posters and 8 oral presentations by student trainees.
