

The Buffalo Translational Consortium Is Now An Institutional Member of ResearchMatch!

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ResearchMatch is a national, web-based volunteer research registry that brings researchers and volunteers together in an anonymous, secure and convenient way to enhance enrollment in clinical studies. The registry currently has over 34,000 volunteers registered nationally.

Registered volunteers receive information about studies anonymously. Their information is not released until they decide to allow the researcher to see it for contact purposes. Researchers with a UB affiliation may register their IRB-approved studies to find willing participants that 'match' their study needs.
