



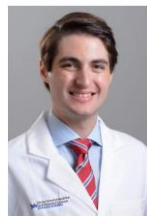

# Unlocking Backward Design for Critical Thinking: Crafting Effective Learning Objectives and Assessments

### Learning Objectives:

- Develop an understanding of the role backward design plays in the curriculum development process.
- Explain what backward design is and why it is important.
- Describe the stages of backward design.
- Describe the levels of Bloom's taxonomy and develop learning objectives to promote higher order thinking.
- Discuss the importance of learning objectives to support student learning, and key principles in their development.
- Describe the importance of aligning assessments with objectives using the backward design process.
