# When is an Informed Consent Truly Informed?



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This workshop will cover the 5 Ws of obtaining truly informed consent. We begin by looking at **W**hat should be covered through an examination of the correspondence between the HRP-503 Protocol Template and HRP-502 Consent Template. We will discuss **W**ho should be involved, **W**hen and **W**here different parts of the consent process should take place, and how to conduct the consent process so that understanding and free choice are achieved. **W**hy each of the above-mentioned areas are important will also be discussed.

Finally, a guide for systematically developing an Informed Consent Process covering the above factors will be presented. A team exercise asking each group to share its analysis of a unique scenario involving a difficulty in achieving truly informed consent will conclude the workshop.
