

ACADEMIC REDUCED COURSE LOAD REQUEST

An Academic Reduced Course Load permits F-1 and J-1 students to reduce their course load below full-time (to a minimum of 6 credits) if they are experiencing academic difficulty. An Academic Reduced Course Load can be used only one time per degree level. To be eligible for an Academic Reduced Course Load, a student must be experiencing one of the following:

Possible Only During the First Year of Study at UB:

- Initial difficulties with the English language
- Initial difficulties with reading requirements
- Unfamiliarity with American teaching methods

Possible throughout the Program of Study:

· Improper course level placement

Students who need a Reduced Course Load must submit a complete application to ISS before the end of the Add/Drop period. If a student is enrolled full-time and realizes after the Add/Drop period that they need an Academic Reduced Course Load, they may also apply. However, they must maintain full-time enrollment until ISS approves the Reduced Course Load. The Reduced Course Load must be signed by the Academic Advisor and approved by ISS BEFORE a student is permitted to drop or resign below full-time.

Graduate students with Assistantships (TAs, RAs, GAs) are not eligible for a Reduced Course Load. UB policy requires 9 credits of registration or Full-time Certification to be eligible for TA, RA or GA appointments. Please consult with the Graduate School in 408 Capen if you have questions about this requirement.

To submit the completed form to ISS, follow the directions below:

- 1. Login to UB Global: http://ubisss.buffalo.edu. Click on the blue "LOGIN" button, and enter your UBIT Name and Password. Note: Do NOT click on "Administrative Services for University Departments".
- 2. Click on F-1 Students should click on "F-1 Student Services" and then "Request for an Academic Reduced Course Load" (J-1 Students click on "J-1 Student Services" first). You must complete the entire E-form and upload a copy of this form (pages 1 and 2). Be sure that both you and your academic advisor have signed the form before you submit it. Note: Only documents saved as a PDF or JPEG are acceptable.

REMEMBER: Do not drop or resign below full-time until ISS approves the Academic Reduced Course Load request. ISS will make a decision (approve or deny), and will notify the student of our decision via email within 5-7 business days of submission.

Once approved by ISS, this Reduced Course Load cannot be canceled.
