

2023-24 INTERNATIONAL APPLICANT FINANCIAL FORM - DPT Program

International applicants must affirm that they are responsible for paying all tuition, fees and living expenses for the entire period of the intended study program. Applicants must document the full cost of only the first year of study before the university can issue a Certificate of Visa Eligibility (Form I-20 or DS-2019).

¹Tuition indicated above is the 2022-23 tuition rate for the academic year only (September–May). Tuition and fees are subject to change. Tuition can increase annually (but doesn't always). The above tuition is for Fall and Spring semesters and is based on the "flat tuition" model where the cost is the same for 12 or more credits (it is not per credit). Summer and Winter session tuition and fees are not included above; Summer and Winter sessions are optional unless required by your program; Summer and Winter tuition is charged per credit; DPT tuition and fees are approximately \$1,500 per credit hour.

The above figures are estimated costs and are subject to change without notice. Total costs typically increase 5% - 8% per annum.

* Dependent Support

An F-1 student wishing to have his or her spouse and/or children accompany him or her must document the following amounts for each family member per academic year of intended study. A marriage certificate (in the original language along with an official English translation) must be provided for the dependent spouse. Birth certificates (in the original language along with an official English translation) must be provided for the dependent children.

Documents must be dated within one year of the anticipated date the student will commence studies. Documents can be clear photocopies, scanned, faxed or original. All documents submitted to UB become the property of UB; they cannot be returned or forwarded to another person/institution.

²Health insurance is listed for a full calendar year.

³Minimum allowance for least expensive on-campus housing and food costs for the Fall and Spring semesters (one academic year); optional Summer and Winter sessions and school breaks are not included (if the student were to live on campus in those periods). The university estimates that students will need an additional \$1,500 or more for books and supplies, and \$1,500 or more for personal expenses and incidental costs.
