Admission is based on the applicant's academic records:

- School marks
- Rigor of school curriculum
- Preparedness for university study
- Test scores (SAT/ACT)
- English language proficiency
- Personal essay
- Teacher recommendations

ADMISSION CRITERIA

SCHOOL MARKS (GPA)

Freshman: B average (or equivalent)

Transfer: C+ average (or equivalent)

SAT/ACT

Freshman: Required for direct admission to certain majors; otherwise optional.

TUITION

\$23,710

Based on 2016–17 cost. Tuition is for one academic year (two semesters). Additional estimated costs, including mandatory fees, health insurance, food and housing allowance, are approximately \$18,154 (plus books and personal expenses). Total cost increases approximately 5 percent annually.

SCHOLARSHIPS

Up to 100% tuition

All students applying to enroll as freshmen in the fall semester are considered for International Admissions Scholarships, which range up to 100 percent of tuition for those with the best academic records. Submission of SAT/ACT scores is highly recommended. No separate application is necessary.

For best consideration, apply before **December 1**.
Last date for consideration is **April 15**.
