## Realizing UB2020

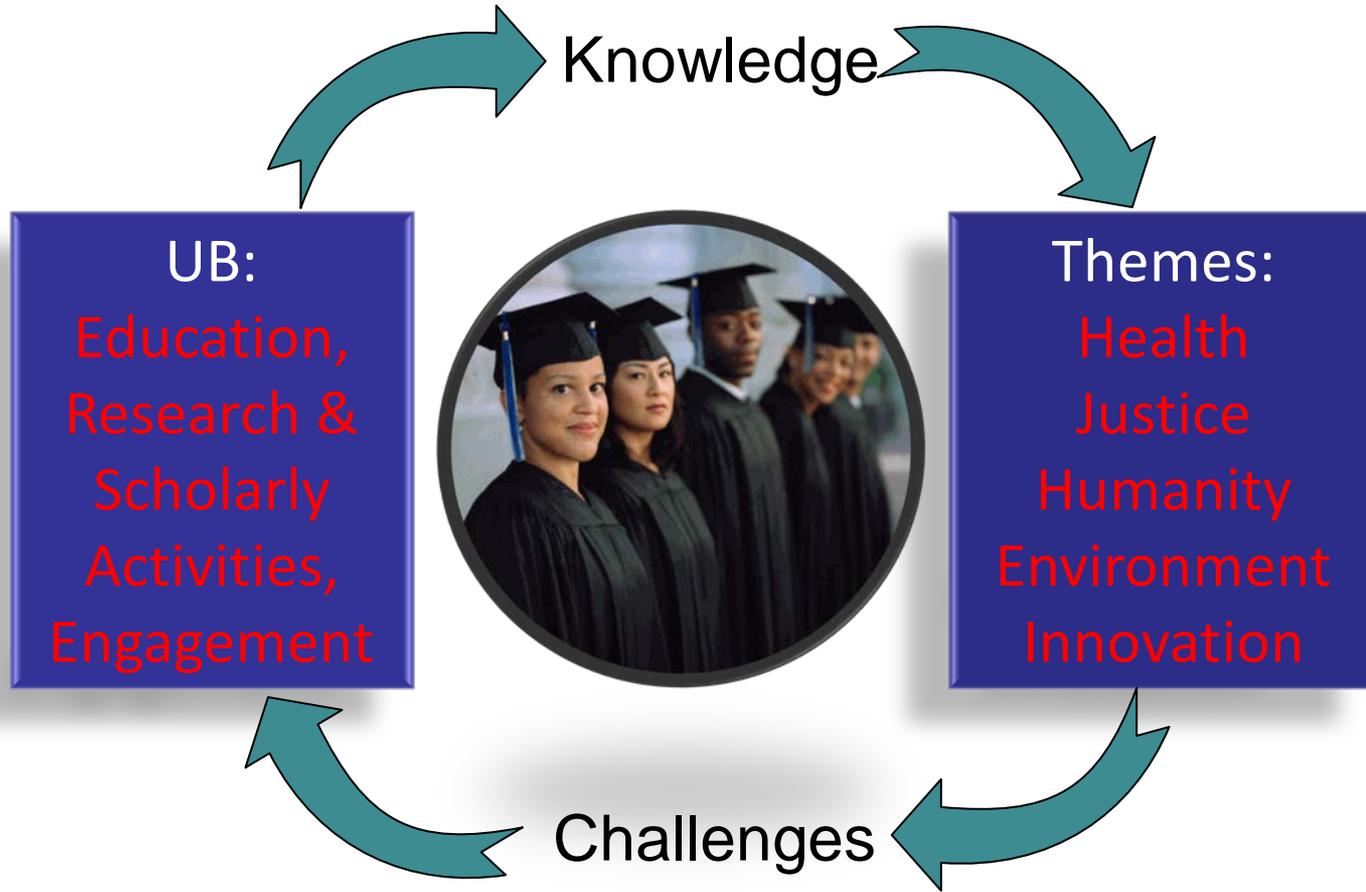
- Launched by President Tripathi and led by Provost Zukoski

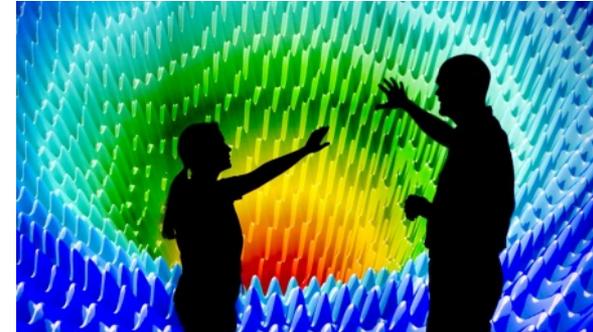
## Concept Papers

- Must include the following:
  - **THE TITLE**
  - **THE SYNOPSIS** - Brief description (maximum of 500 words)
  - **THE OUTCOMES** - Relative to learning, scholarship, creative activity and engagement (maximum of 500 words)
  - **THEMES IMPACTED** - Simple list
  - **TARGETED FUNDING SOURCES** - Potential

# Preliminary Proposal Presentations

- Includes (in up to a maximum of 11 slides):
  - Title (1 Slide):
  - Project Summary (2 slides):
    - Succinct summary and
    - Broader impacts
  - Project Description (Up to 7 slides):
    - Vision and Goals
    - Approach and Methodology
    - Scientific/Creative Merit, Scholarly Activities and Impact
    - Statement of Resource Needs
    - Metrics/Definition of Success
  - Institutional Fit (1 slide)
  - Handout (extra): List of all participating faculty, their departmental affiliations, and their expertise.
