Dear UB Students and Student Leaders:

In an effort to assist you with planning, the University is providing you with the approved Broad-based Fee rates for 2020/21.

After extensive consultation with the SUNY System Administration, the 2020/21 Comprehensive Fee rates have been approved for increases totaling an annual increase of 2.03%, which includes the addition of a Career Services Fee. The 2020/21 Academic Excellence and Success Fee annual rate remains at the rate of \$525.00 annually.

The individual fee component increases for 2020/21 are as follows:

As a result of the deferral of Fall 2020 MAC sports to Spring 2021, the Fall 2020 Athletics Fee rate will be reduced by \$53.00, resulting in a charge of \$212.75 for the *Fall 2020 semester only*. Additionally, the University at Buffalo’s broad-based fee waiver policy has been updated accordingly in response to the COVID-19 pandemic.
