This report contains a detailed statistical analysis of the results to the survey titled *2007 Student IT Experience Survey*. The results analysis includes answers from all respondents who took the survey in the 21 day period from Wednesday, October 31, 2007 to Tuesday, November 20, 2007. 3415 completed responses were received to the survey during this time.
