Distinguished Alumna 2022 Reverend Tanya Spencer Class of 1992



The Distinguished Alumni Award is presented annually to an alumna or alumnus who demonstrates the Buffalo Educational Opportunity Center mission of lifelong learning and who is self-empowered and committed to excellence.

REVEREND TANYA SPENCER

Reverend Tanya Spencer's achievements are testament to the self-empowerment values of the BEOC.

A graduate of the Dental Assisting program, Reverend Spencer worked as a Dental Assistant for eight years. While working, she earned an Associates in Liberal Arts from SUNY Erie and her Licensed Practical Nurse (LPN) certificate from BOCES. From 2005-2019 she worked at Buffalo Pediatrics, initially as a LPN and later as Office Manager. Earning a Bachelor of Science degree in Business Administration from Houghton College, Reverend Spencer was hired as a BEOC Adjunct Instructor teaching Pre-LPN, Electronic Health Records and Patient Services Technician courses.

Reverend Spencer's life re-focused when she answered a faith based calling. Earning a Masters in Strategic Leadership from Robert Wesleyan College and a Masters of Divinity from Northeastern Seminary, she became a Baptist Minister and an ordained Elder for the Free Methodist Tradition. Presently, she serves on the Executive Committee for the NY State Council of Churches where her work on the Poor People's Campaign provides a voice to the Governor to increase wages and expand fair housing opportunities. Last year, Reverend Spencer was ordained and recognized in the American Baptist denomination. Currently, she is the Pastor of Good Shepherd Community of Faith in Buffalo and the Orchard Park United Methodist Church in Orchard Park.


BEOC Alumni Affairs sponsored a book drive during the months of November and December to benefit ParentChild+, an international organization with a local site at the King Urban Life Center. The mission of the early childhood program is to develop literacy and language skills in children aged 18 months to 4 years, ensuring they enter pre-school and kindergarten reading at grade level. 42 families graduated last year from the program after completing 2 years of home based literacy activities.

The drive was very successful. BEOC alumni, along with faculty and staff, donated 170 books in support of this community initiative.

Margot Barrett Keysor, Alumni Affairs Administrator, presented the books on behalf of alumni, faculty and staff, to Cheryl Williams-Manney, ParentChild+ Program Coordinator.
