



Dress Code for UBEOC Allied Health Programs (RMA, CST, PST, MBC, CNA)

Students must adhere to the following UBEOC Allied Health dress attire requirements:

- Uniform must be clean, neat in appearance
- Uniform scrubs eggplant (dark purple) in color
- White lab jacket
- EOC Name Badge
- Comfortable footwear ie: Crocs are prohibited (black or white sneakers) or (black or white clinical shoes)
- No Spandex, midriff tops, inappropriate under garments, outerwear (coats, boots), sweat pants, sweat tops, undersized clothing, oversized attire and hip huggers are prohibited. Hats, head wraps, scarf's, silk wraps, hair bonnets, hoodies are prohibited i.e. cultural attire is excluded, artificial nails are prohibited, professional in appearance (refrain from fashionable hair colors) and artificial eye lashes within the Central Sterilization Technician Program
- Second hand watch if required ie: direct patient care programs



- Certified Nurse Assistant and Central Sterilization Recertification Program – Uniform scrubs of any color must be clean and neat in appearance
- Compliance with the Allied Health Program Dress Code is a requirement for all classes
