Meeting History (meeting dates, conference calls, major discussions):

The Committee last met in January 2015 to discuss a new Academic Integrity Policy and a revised Course Enrollment Policy. The Academic Integrity Policy discussion was postponed pending further talks between the Office of Academic Affairs and the Graduate School.

The Committee proposed changes to the Course Enrollment Policy to allow students who wished to repeat a Controlled Enrollment Course to do so in the Fall or Spring Semesters (rather than only in the Winter or Summer Sessions) if there were seats available after all eligible students had had a chance to enroll.

After multiple drafts and much back and forth on the telephone and via email, a policy was finalized between the Office of Academic Affairs, the Registrar, the CAS Dean's Office, and the APGC. The policy was forwarded to the Faculty Senate and approved unanimously at its meeting on May 5, 2015, whereupon it seems to have been lost. Happily it was finally enacted by the President on December 22, 2015.

In the meanwhile, I am assured the Academic Integrity Policies for Undergraduates and Graduate Students have been revised and will be sent to the Senate for Approval. At that point I anticipate that the APGC will be asked to review the policies and make a recommendation to the Senate.
