#### Chair's report.

- 1. Entrepreneur Expo: On May 3<sup>rd</sup> University at Buffalo held its Bright Buffalo Niagara Entrepreneur Expo at Hotel Henry with Pocket Sun giving the keynote address. The first place was awarded to Legworks, a company that develops high quality, affordable prosthetics.
- Boldly Buffalo: The University at Buffalo launched the largest fundraising campaign in university history and SUNY. The Campaign, Boldly Buffalo seeks to raise \$650 million for UB to deliver transformative changes. The University has already secured \$451 million.
- 3. Breathe Free UB update: SUNY labor unions have opposed the SUNY Tobacco Free legislation since it is subject to collective bargaining. The committee's focus now is to get the unions to recognize this as an exercise in union membership engagement.
- 4. The Tenure, Promotion and Privileges Committee needs to be reenergized. Their charge is: This Committee shall review, report and recommend to the senate matters concerning standards within the university regarding appointment, promotion and tenure of faculty, and matters concerning faculty rights and privileges. A call has been sent out to all voting faculty for new members.

5. Special meeting: There will be a special meeting of FS following the Annual Faculty Meeting May 15<sup>th</sup>. During this meeting the GESS Committee will share their results.
