Appendix 2: Chair's Report

Faculty Senate Executive Committee Meeting

Chair's Report October 4, 2022

Don Erb, the Professional Staff Senate's Vice-Chair, and I attended last week's dedication of the Indigenous Studies Department. After and general overview of the Department, its history, present, and future, I had the opportunity to tell those present that the Department is invited to provide both Senates with information vital to the respective Senate's function and opportunities.

Last week with the assistance of the Faculty Senate Secretary, Cindi Tysick, every Committee Chair (if there is no Chair, the entire Committee was contacted) and given a deadline of October 25, 2022 to provide a report about their committee. The Faculty Senate Executive Committee WILL hear from each of the committees before the end of the Fall Semester. As noted in several emails I sent in the Fall 2021 Semester that were directed to the Faculty Senate, the Faculty Senate Executive Committee, and individual committees requesting assistance in re-populating Committees, and reporting back to the FSEC.

The weakness of the Faculty Senate Committees was in the Final Report of the Ad-hoc Institutional Review Committee. The Faculty Senate needs to address this issue head-on and strengthen the critical starting points for creation, approval, and implementation of University programs, policies, and resolutions that determine the direction of the University's future.

Kristin Stapleton, Chair of the Ad-hoc Institutional Review Committee, presented their Final Report to the Faculty Senate Executive Committee, and completed its charge. At today's meeting, we will formally acknowledge their report and dismiss the ad hoc Committee. The Senate thanks Kristin and her Committee for the work they did in preparing this document. The next thing needed, after we accept the report, is what are the responsibilities the Faculty Executive Committee has moving this report forward. I want the FSEC to have some time to fully read and analyze this report, and engage in a conversation that address the question, "Where do we go from here?"

We will hear today in Executive Session the first presentation of the ad hoc Faculty Satisfaction Committee, Chaired by Barbara Prinari. This is a review of the questions contained in a survey to UB's Faculty with a planned release in the Spring Semester.
