a. Would like to make a note regarding 9/6/17 meeting: changes were made to the statement Chair Glick made – request to add to minutes:

# Correction of the record and of statements made by FSEC Chair Dr. Philip Glick FSEC Meeting of September 6, 2017:

In response to misrepresentations made to this body by the FSEC Chair as recorded and posted in the FSEC "box", I would like to correct the record from the September 6 meeting:

Last week, Chair Glick stated that I have been seeking SUNY Counsel's advice with increasing frequency

- I confer with SUNY Counsel only when requests are made that are outside the bounds of the standard rules and policies under which we operate. If there is increasing frequency, it is because the Senate Chair is increasingly asking me to undertake activities that require interpretation of the SUNY Board of Trustees Policies.
- Secondly, contrary to what Chair Glick stated last week, there is no such thing as a "presidential compassionate reappointment". This appointment does not exist.
- Reappointing an individual who had previously been non-renewed is allowed under the SUNY BOT policies.
- That is quite different from appointing an individual to the state payroll for the sole purpose of
  providing them with disability insurance, which was the expressed purpose of the request from
  Chair Glick.
- As provost, my obligation is to be a responsible steward of UB resources and to act with
  integrity in carrying out my responsibilities. I cannot agree to the reappointment of a faculty
  member for the sole purpose of obtaining paid state benefits. This would be an improper use of
  state funds and meets my standard of fraudulent behavior.
- Finally, to mitigate future misunderstandings regarding what I have and have not said, I will only
  meet with Chair Glick in the presence of others, namely a member of my staff as well as the
  Secretary of the FSEC.
- I look forward to getting on with the serious business of the Senate, including today's report
  on the Gender Equity Salary Study.
