Interim Provost's report: Dr. Weber reported success of the Smiles for Veterans initiative and the Veterans Day Service at UB. New business:

- 1. Presentation by Christopher Hollister and Jeff Good: UB Open Access Policy for Scholarly and Creative Works. – SUNY is requesting each campus to develop a policy regarding open access publishing by staff and faculty. (see
 - UB Open Access Policy v2.1.1.docx)
 - a. discussion focused on the use of the word "compliance" in the Responsibility section of the document. The concern was that this document "encourages" open access publishing, but does not go so far as to mandate it; the Responsibility section speaks of implementing practice to support "compliance" could lead to interpreting this policy as a mandate. Discussed, but not supported with a vote.
 - b. discussion on the need to include "opt-in or opt-out" terms in the document. To support faculty independence in making decision to publish open access, a statement "That is, this is an opt-in rather than an opt-out policy for University authors" was added to the first paragraph under the Policy Statement section of the document. This addition was supported with FSEC vote of 14 for, 1 against, 2 abstain.
- 2. Presentation by Sue Snyder on the status of Health Services for UB students. Sue reported on Kimball Hall (South campus) services. It was suggested that the medical school be approached and serve as a training site for medical students. NP students already use the site for clinical rotations.
