Provost's report:

Faculty accolades: To study the molecular dysfunctions underlying Alzheimer's disease, UB researcher Ying Xu received a \$3.9 million grant from the National Institute on Aging, specifically to examine the role of phosphodiesterases (PDEs) in cognition and behavior.

UB engineering researchers have received 1,4 million from The U.S. Army Engineer Research and Development Center's Cold Regions Research and Engineering Laboratory to develop a portable solar still — a device that generates clean water using the power of the sun.

The School of Dental Medicine has received a \$780,000 grant from the Mother Cabrini Health Foundation to expand its successful S-Miles to Go dental program through the addition of a second, drivable mobile dental clinic.

Irus Braverman, professor of law and William J. Magavern Faculty Scholar is named the National Humanities Center residential fellow for 2021.

Katherine Zubovich, Assistant Professor, Department of History received the Pushkin Prize for her work, <u>Moscow Monumental: Soviet Skyscrapers and</u> <u>Urban Life in Stalin's Capital</u>.

Pamela Paplham, clinical professor and assistant dean for MS/DNP programs at the School of Nursing, has been named a fellow of the American



Academy of Nurses, an honor that is among the most prestigious milestones in a nurse leader's career.

Steven D. Schwaitzberg, MD, chair of the Department of Surgery in the Jacobs School of Medicine and Biomedical Sciences at the University at Buffalo, was inducted into the American College of Surgeons Academy of Master Surgeon Educators.

Presentation: Bob Granfield introduced the COACHE survey, which was followed by a presentation by Todd Benson and subsequently the floor was opened for discussion. UB conducted the survey in 2017 and the results are available on the website of the Vice Provost for Faculty Affairs.

The COACHE instrument is a faculty satisfaction survey developed at Harvard to (1) gain insights into carefully crafted themes such as Research, Teaching, Service support, Leadership, Mentorship, Tenure and promotion, Appreciation & recognition, Retention and negotiations etc. (2) Benchmark faculty's experience of the academic workplace within both internal and national contexts, and (3) Enabling comparison of the data against a selfselected group of peer institutions, as well as the pool of national results. The survey results illuminate disparities in perceptions about the academic workplace between faculty of different racial and ethnic backgrounds. A suggestion was to include part-time faculty in these discussions as their experience would be different.
