f. *Shared Governance Day*: The fourth annual Shared Governance Day at UB will be Tuesday March 5<sup>th</sup>.

g. *Students*: i. Food insecurity and the creation of a Food Pantry on the North Campus. Scott Weber has created a Food Insecurity Committee. The FS has asked for more participation/representation of the Senate.

ii. October is Suicide prevention Month. Gate Keeper is training more widely available on campus.

h. *The SUNY UFS Fall Planning Meeting* was held on September 20-21 in Saratoga Springs. Report of the meeting was presented.

### Parliamentarian's report: None.

#### **Provost's report**:

- (a) Provost Zukowski spoke about the UBFunds for building and recovery.
- (b) He spoke about the trends in graduate stipends.
- (c) The University at Buffalo launched a multidisciplinary artificial intelligence institute the University at Buffalo Artificial Intelligence Institute (UBuffalo.AI) to explore how to combine machines' superior ability to ingest, connect and recall information with concepts that humans excel at, such as reasoning, judgement and strategizing, to develop dynamic human-machine partnerships. The AI institute will be lead by David Doermann, PhD, from the University of Maryland (UMD) and the Defense Advanced Research Projects Agency (DARPA).
- (d) African/American task force received a \$800,000 center for disease control prevention grant to study methods to prevent health disparities of African/Americans in Buffalo. Gregory Fabiano, associate dean for interdisciplinary research in the Graduate School of Education received a \$3.3 million U.S. Department of Education grant to study how best to treat ADHD for the full school year. Department of Physics received 1.4 million dollar grant from NSF. Bio-XL has received

continued funding of the 22.5 million to continue studying molecular structures by X-ray scattering and crystallography. It was established in 2013. To date they have discovered 352 new molecular structures and have 500 publications to their credit.

**New business:** FS budget report was presented by Phil Glick for the sake of transparency.

**Unfinished business:** There was a discussion on the pros and cons of units splitting their seat(s) on the FSEC. The standing orders state that FSEC cannot designate alternates, as opposed to FS members. A continued discussion will be held in two weeks.
