Faculty Senate Meeting October 17, 2017 Center for Tomorrow 3.00-4.30pm

Meeting was called to order at 3.00pm By Prof. Phil Glick.

The meeting was recorded.

1. Agenda: The agenda for 10/17 FS meeting was approved at the 10/11/2017 FSEC meeting.

2. Minutes: Minutes of 9/18 FS meeting was approved unanimously.

3. Chair's Report

a. A moment of silence was maintained in memory of Prof Richard Adler, a cardiac surgeon and a member of the UB faculty for > 28 years who died on September 21, 2017 at the age of 95. A memorial service will be held in conjunction with the Department of surgery's grand rounds December 14^{th} .

b. Graham L. Hammill has been appointed Vice Provost for Educational Affairs and Dean of the Graduate School, effective October 11, 2017. This is a new administrative position.

c. Shared Governance Continuing Education: Safe Zone & Cultural Competency Training was held earlier this month. ~ 40 faculty and professional staff attended.

d. Planning continues for the UB to host the spring 2018 UFS Plenary April 19-21st.

e. Last academic year the FS unanimously passed the Faculty Senate Resolution to Protect Non-US Citizen Members of the UB Community and was sent to President Tripathi's office. Negotiations are ongoing to clear any concerns and move the resolution forward so that it will have an easier path to presidential signature of promulgation to policy

f. SUNY Office of Diversity, Equity and Inclusion and the University Faculty Senate will be hosting a conference entitled "Engaging Diversity, Equity and Inclusivity in the Classroom, Campus and Community: Celebrating a Decade of Transformational Diversity Leadership" on November 29-December 1, 2017 at the Albany Marriott Hotel, located at 189 Wolf Road, Albany, New York.

g. On October 19 and 20, your UB SUNY UFS Senators, CGL's will be will be attending the Fall UFS 177th Plenary meeting in Delhi NY.

h. Professor Mike Hatton suggested changing SUNY Policy regarding the reading of military rank of graduates at all SUNY Commencements. A resolution has been submitted to the UFS Student Life Committee. If it is forwarded to the UFS Executive Committee later this fall it will get a 1st reading at the Winter UFS plenary and a second reading and vote at the Spring 2018 plenary hosted by UB. It would then be forwarded to the Chancellor for consideration of promulgation toward a SUNY Policy.

i. We have 13 UB FS Committees. Anyone in UB is welcome to serve on them.

j. Professor Cemal Basaran suggested the FS start a yearly UB FS Shared Governance Award to be given to the faculty member, staff member, VProvosts, VPresidents, Dean, department chair or committee members who best exhibit the values of Shared governance. Cemal will chair this committee. The award will be presented at our annual March Shared governance Day Event.

k. The GESS (Gender equity Salary Study) Committee is holding its 2 town hall meetings in the next week.

Graham Hammill, V Provost of Graduate Education and Interim VP for undergraduate education is starting a search for the new VP for undergraduate education and he has asked the FSEC for two senior faculty members to serve on this search. The FSEC nominated Professor Susan Udin and Professor Jim Jenson, Faculty Director, Research Exploration Undergraduate Academy.
