

#### Faculty Senate Meeting December 15, 2020 Online by Zoom

Attendance:

The Chair, Dr. Robert Miletich called the Meeting to order at 3.00pm.

Agenda: Agenda was approved unanimously.

**Secretary's report**: The Secretary reminded everyone that run off election for the position of FS Chair was in progress and encouraged all Senators to vote.

Minutes from the meeting of November 17, 2020 was accepted unanimously.

**President's report:** The President gave an update of the Fall semester. Even though these were unprecedented times caused by the pandemic, the students continued to receive exceptional education and UB has continued its mission of reaching the top 25. He thanked the faculty for their hard work.

The research enterprise continues its forward trajectory with Jean Wactawski-Wende received 8.1 million from the NIH for the Womens Health Initiative. The DOE has awarded a UB research team \$8.5 million to study hybrid rockets, a technology that could provide a safer and less expensive way to explore outer space compared to conventional rockets.

Xiaoliang Zhang, SUNY Empire Innovation Professor in the Department of Biomedical Engineering, is leading a team of researchers — from UB; University of California, Berkeley; Stanford University; University of Minnesota; Cleveland Clinic; and GE Global Research — to develop advanced MRI techniques. Funded by a five-year, \$3.7 million Bioengineering Research Partnership U01 grant from the National Institutes of Health, the team will develop sensitive imaging tools for morphological and functional characterization of ligaments, tendons and bone, which are essential for studying semi-solid connective tissues in health and disease.



He gave a brief overview of all the student programs such as mental health, tutoring, career service, creative writing etc. UB football team has ranked in top 25.

**Provost's report:** The Provost stated that all in person classes were stopped after the Thanksgiving break. UB continues to conduct surveillance testing and maintains a positivity rate of less than 0.5%. Spring break was removed to reduce the spread of the virus. Spring session would be online or hybrid based on the courses.

UBs research enterprise continues during COVID19. UB scientists are testing melatonin as a treatment for patients with mild and moderate COVID-19. UB's Institutional Review Board has granted approval to the researchers to use melatonin to treat COVID-19 patients under an Investigational New Drug Approval provisionally granted by the FDA.

'Four UB professors have been elected fellows of the American Association for the Advancement of Science (AAAS), the world's largest general scientific society and publisher of the journal Science.

The new UB fellows include:

- Eaton Lattman, emeritus professor of materials design and innovation in the School of Engineering and Applied Sciences, and of structural biology in the Jacobs School of Medicine and Biomedical Sciences at UB.
- Xiufeng Liu, professor of learning and instruction in the Graduate School of Education.
- Janet Morrow, UB Distinguished Professor and Larkin Professor of Chemistry in the College of Arts and Sciences.
- Stefan Ruhl, professor of oral biology in the School of Dental Medicine. AAAS fellows will be recognized in the journal Science on Nov. 27. An induction ceremony will be held during the virtual AAAS Fellows Forum on Feb. 13.'

William J. Jusko, SUNY Distinguished Professor of Pharmaceutical Sciences in the School of Pharmacy and Pharmaceutical Sciences, has received the 2020 Distinguished Pharmaceutical Scientist Award from the American Association of Pharmaceutical Sciences (AAPS).

Samantha Barbas, Professor of Law. University at Buffalo School of Law won the highly competitive 2020 Public Scholars Program from the National Endowment for the Humanities (NEH).
