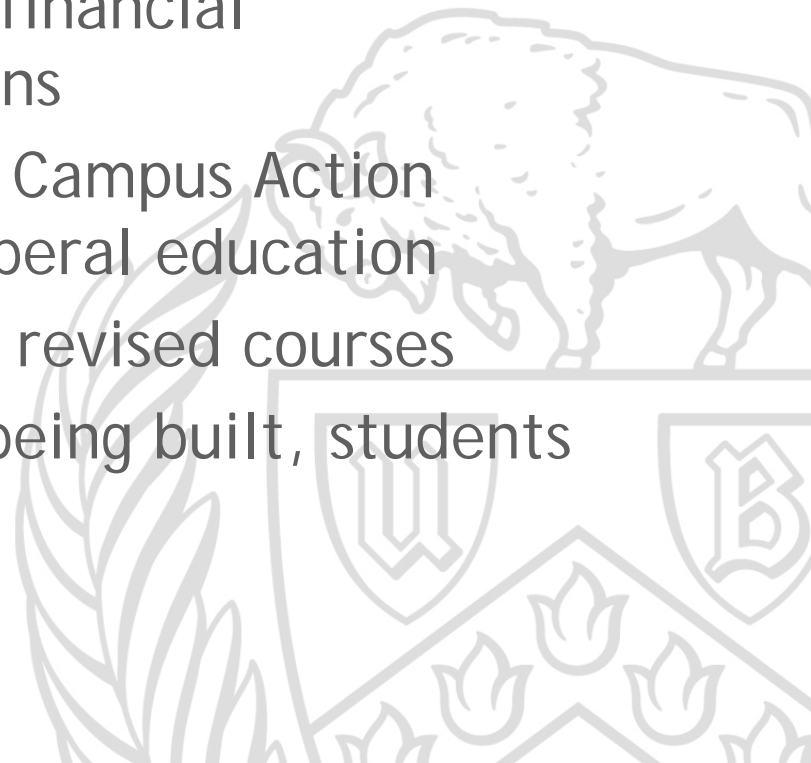

## Timeline to Date

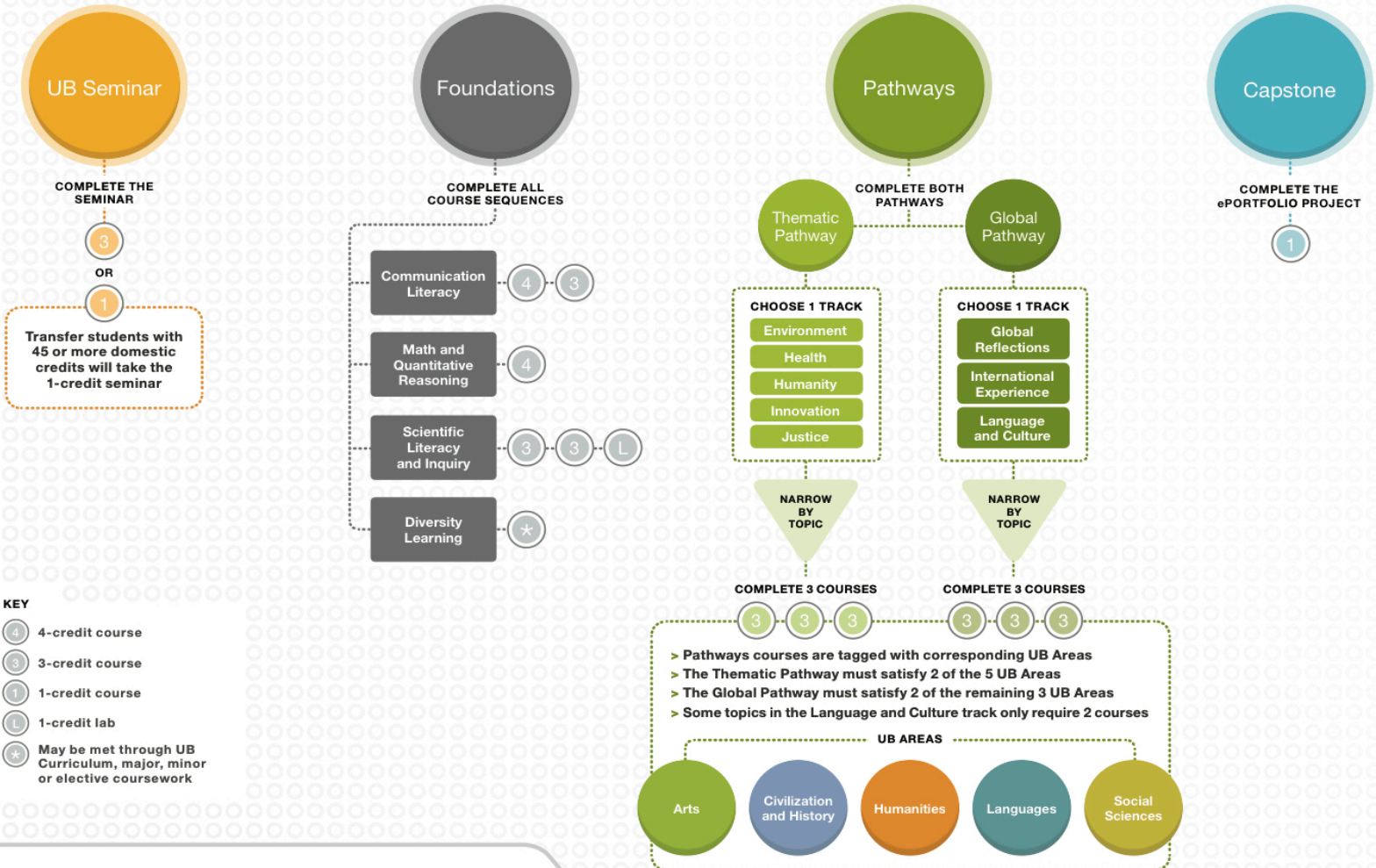
- Dec 2014: Faculty Senate pass new Gen Ed program
- Jan 2015: Formation of implementation committees
- May 2015: Seat expectations/financial commitments agreed with deans
- June 2015: UB becomes LEAP Campus Action Network campus, advancing liberal education
- Oct 2015: Deadline for new & revised courses
- Jan 2016: Fall '16 schedules being built, students recruited





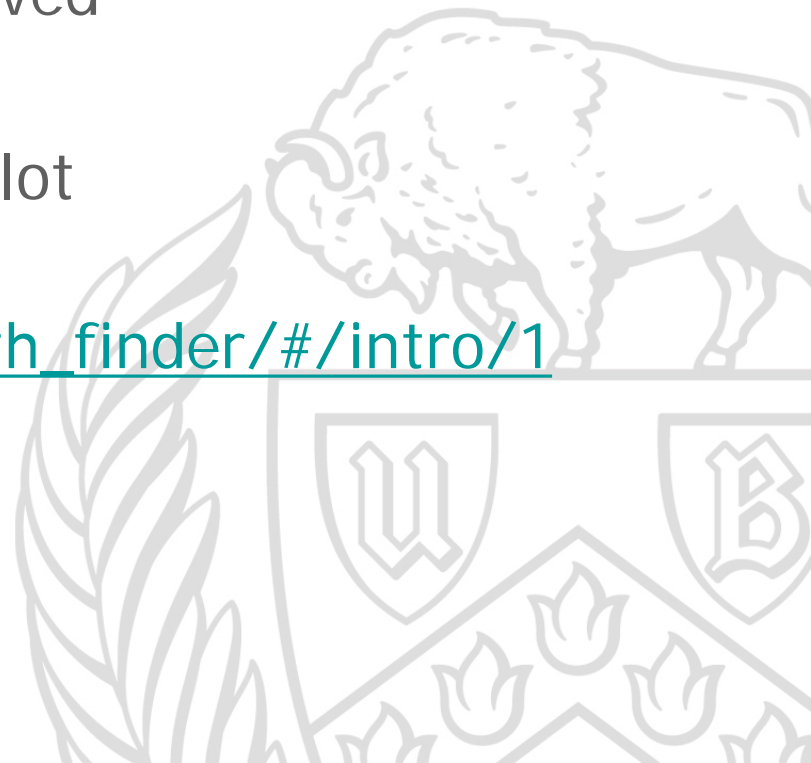
# UB CURRICULUM

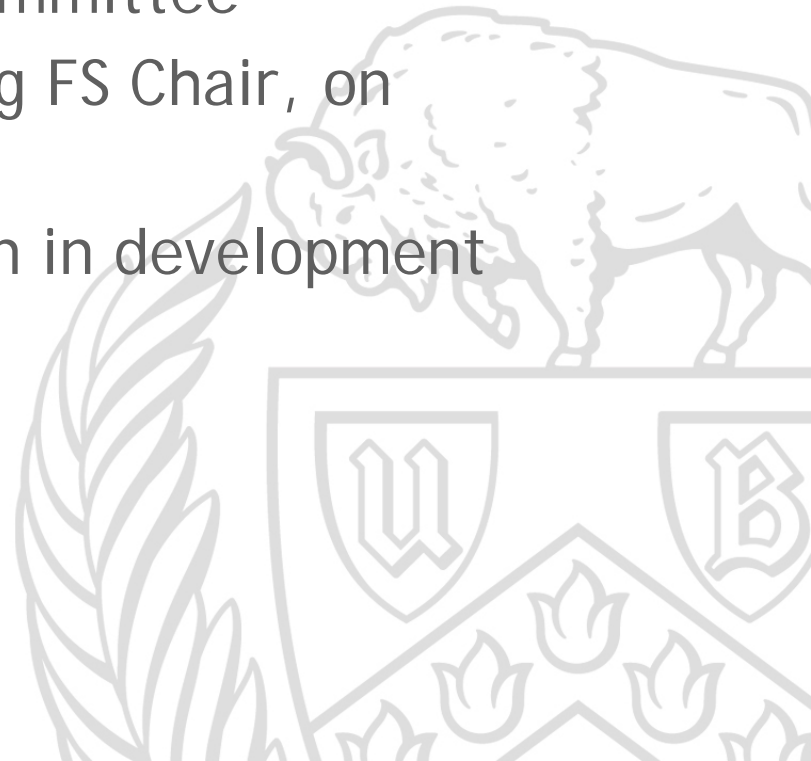
# Highlights
