Our History

- 1846--leading citizens—primarily physicians and lawyers—proposed that an institution of higher learning be established, which led to the founding of the private, nonsectarian University of Buffalo.
- Medical classes began February 24, 1847, with an enrollment of 66 students.

- School's first location was next to Buffalo General Hospital in downtown Buffalo.
- 1893- School relocated to High Street, where it remained until 1953, when it moved to the South Campus.
- 1962- University of Buffalo merged with the State University of New York.
- 1987- School's name changed to the School of Medicine and Biomedical Sciences.
- 2015- School's named changed to Jacobs School of Medicine and Biomedical Sciences.






