Our History

- 1846--leading citizens—primarily physicians and lawyers—proposed that an institution of higher learning be established, which led to the founding of the private, nonsectarian University of Buffalo.
- Medical classes began February 24, 1847, with an enrollment of 66 students.

Our Story

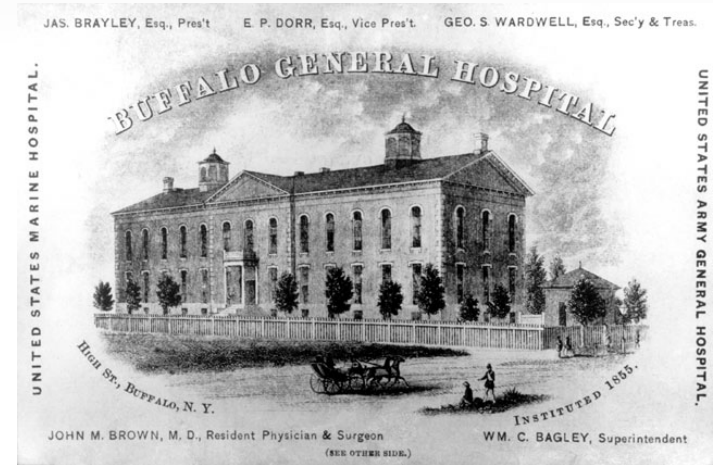
School's first location was next to Buffalo General Hospital in downtown Buffalo.

1893- School relocated to High Street, where it remained until 1953, when it moved to the South Campus.

1962- University of Buffalo merged with the State University of New York.

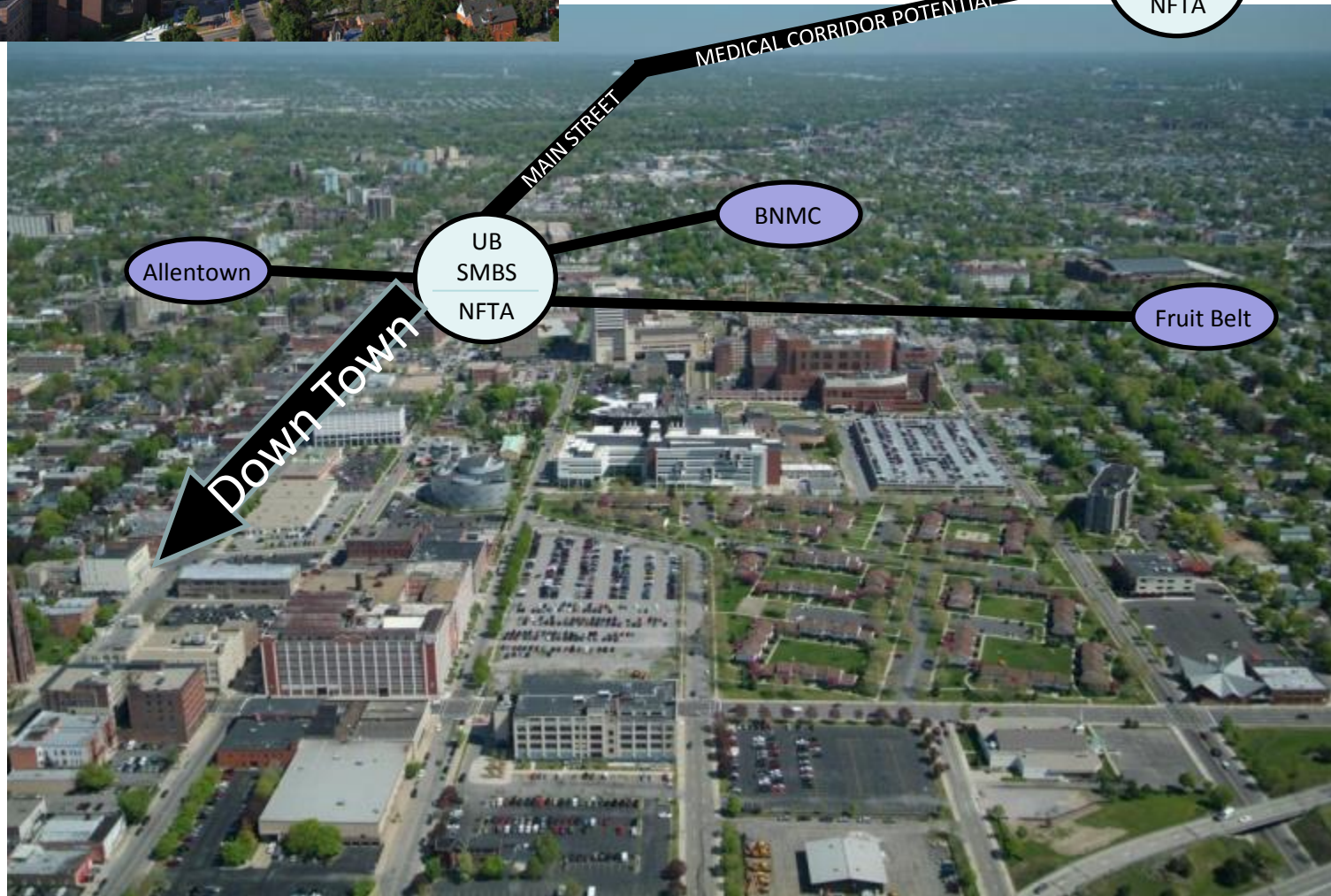
1987- School's name changed to the School of Medicine and Biomedical Sciences.

2015- School's name changed to Jacobs School of Medicine and Biomedical Sciences.

- Fall 2018 - move in

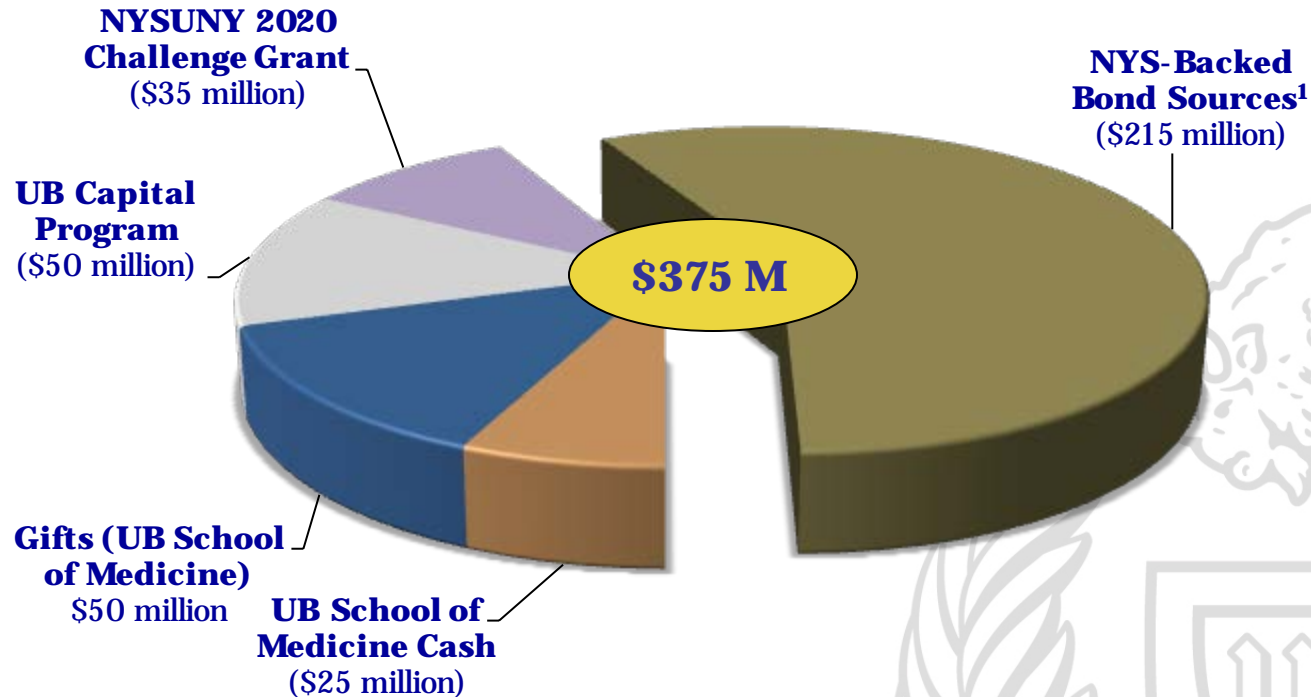

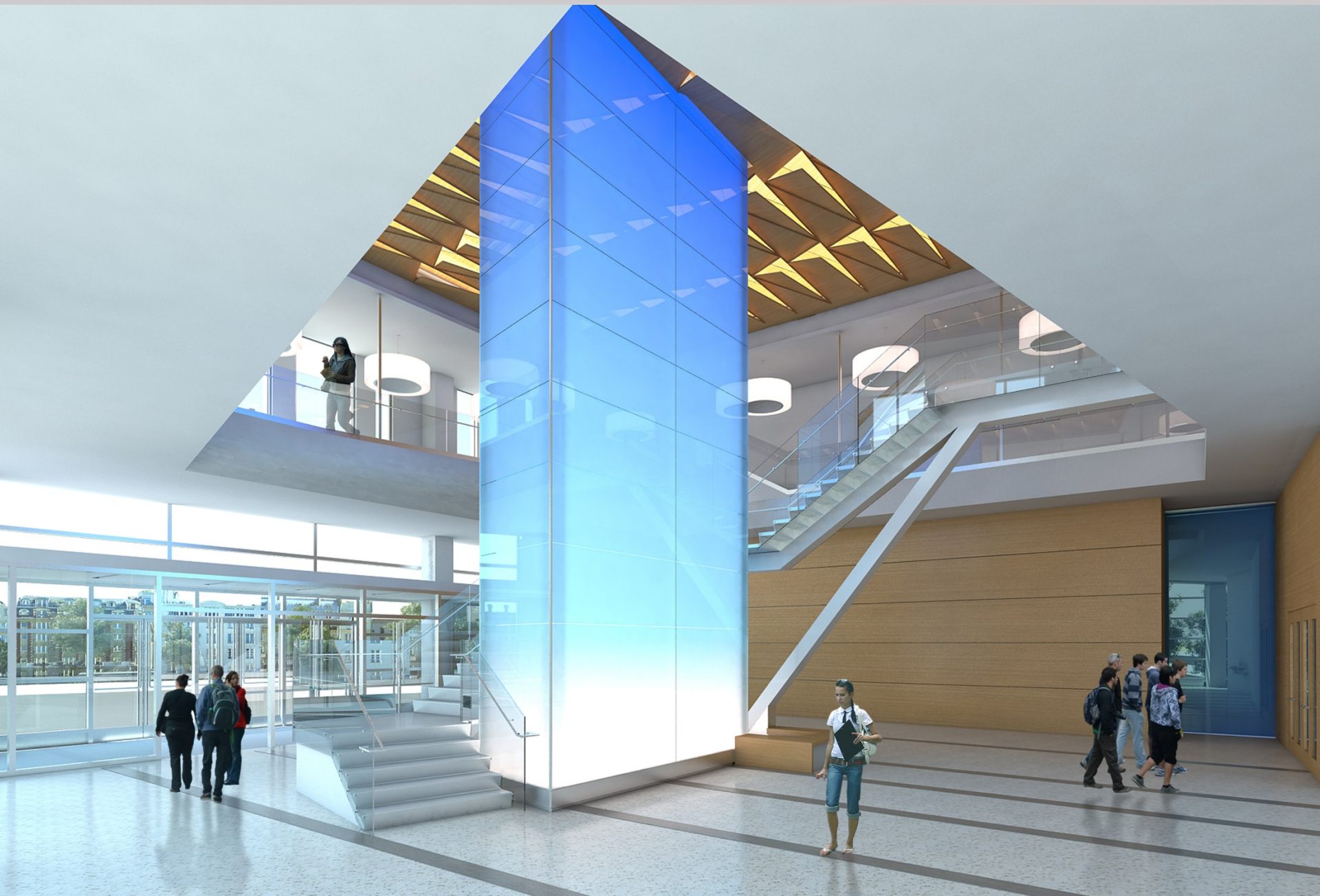


¹ UB pays debt service from campus revenues (indirect cost recovery from grants, endowments, gift income, sales and service income, etc.)

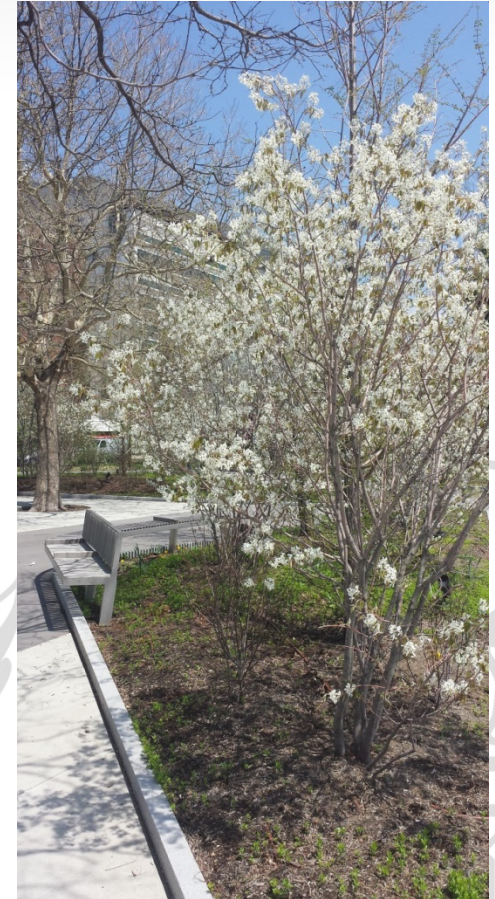

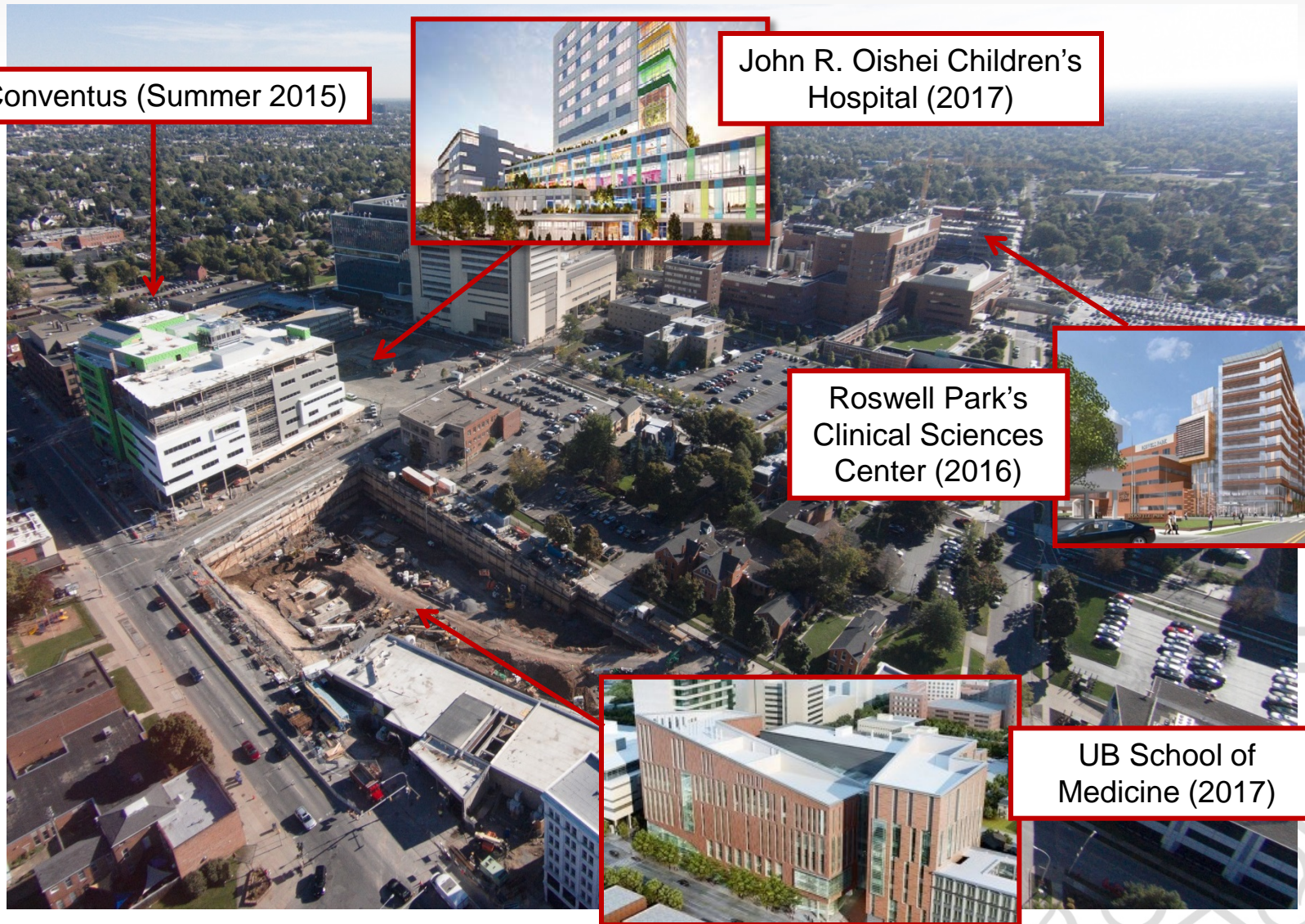

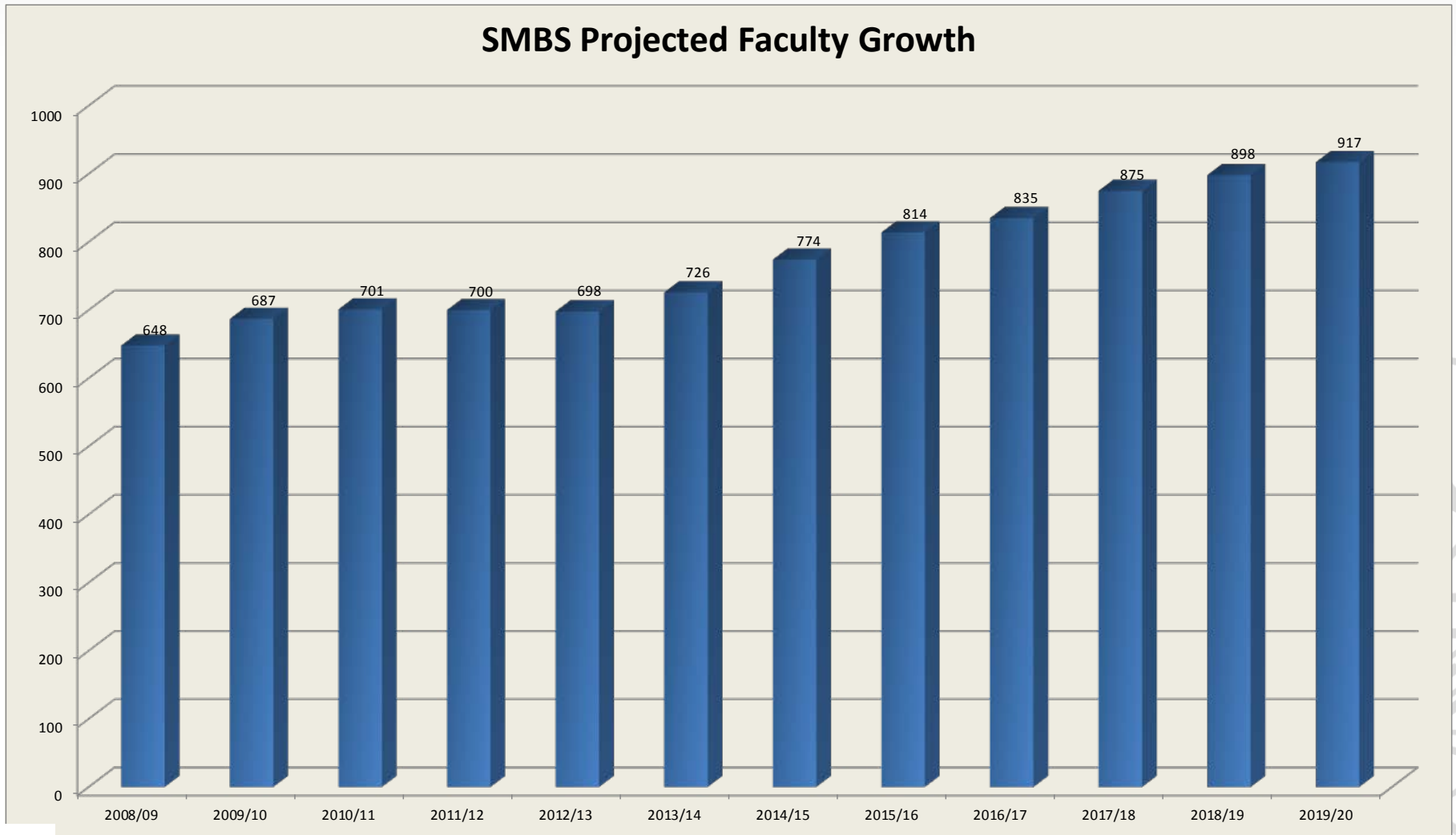

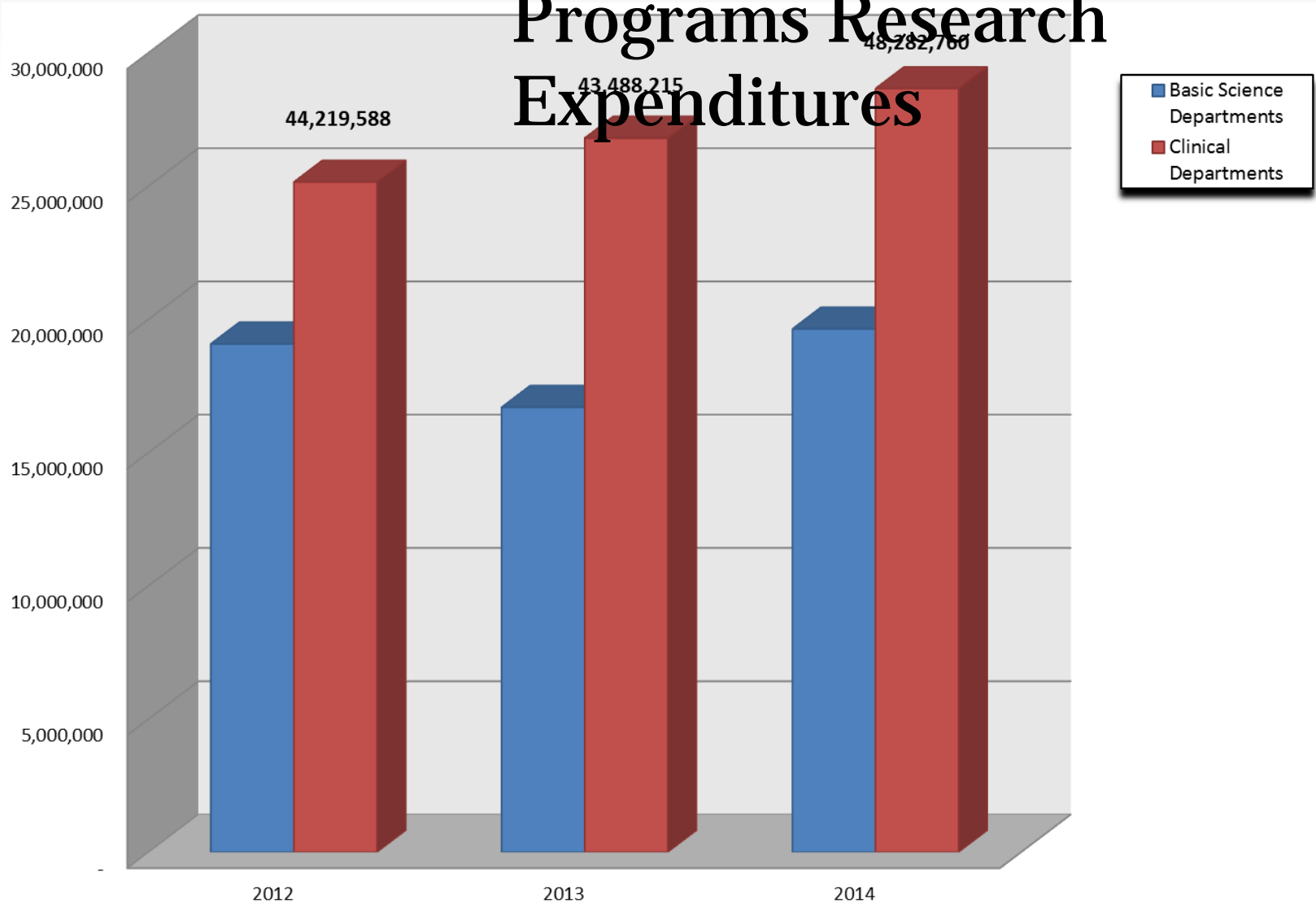

SMBS Total Sponsored Programs Research Expenditures



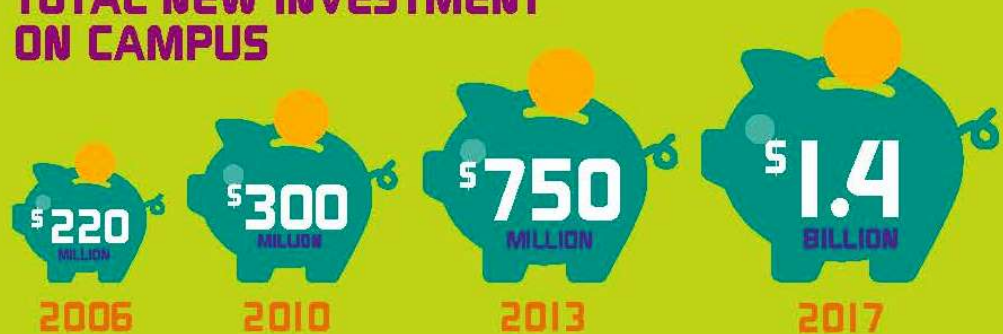

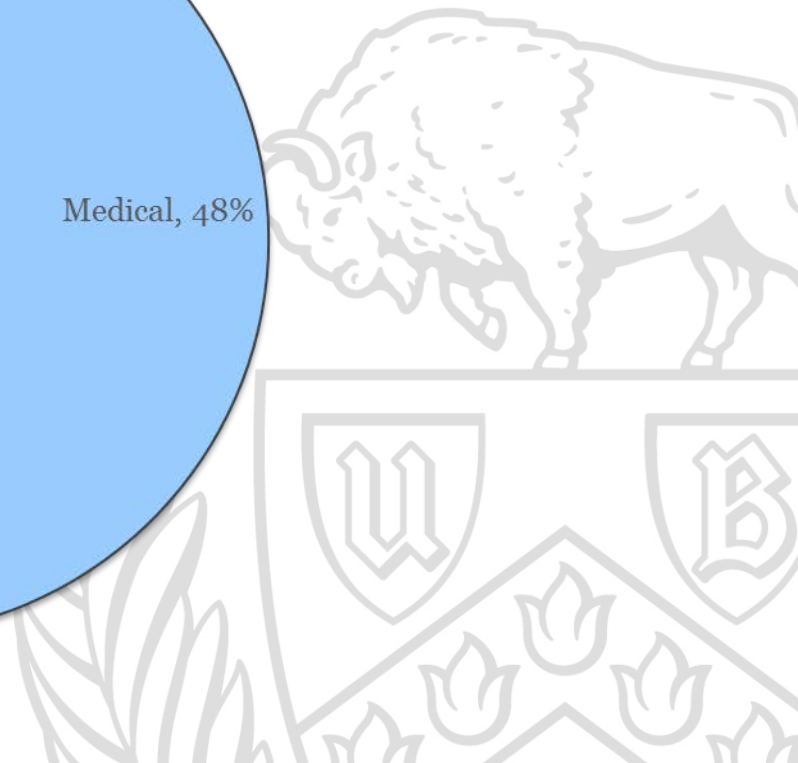
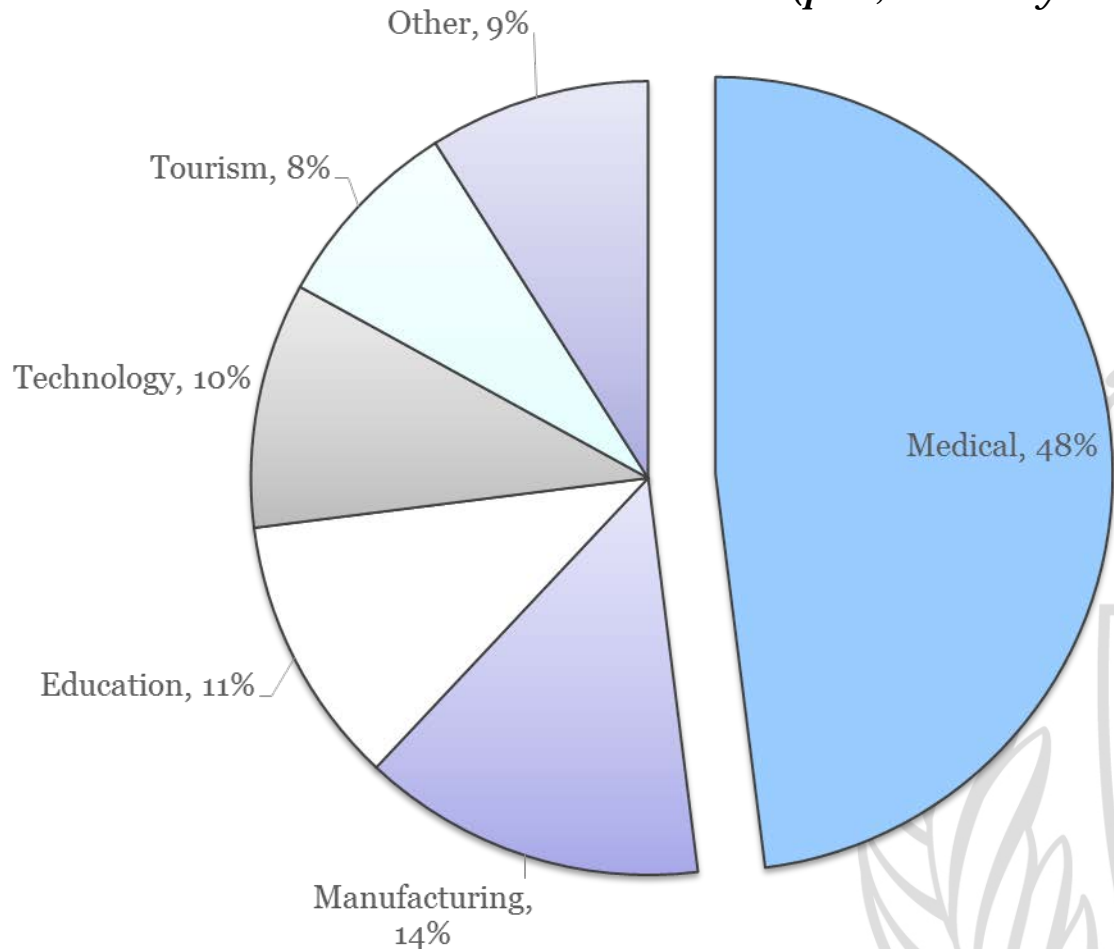
