

UB Teaching Innovation Award FAQ

Award: Teaching Innovation Award (TI)

Eligibility:

- Nominee must be a full-time faculty.

Information:

- Innovative teaching can be demonstrated in a variety of ways, including
 - incorporating diverse methods/strategies to engage students;
 - designing or revising assessment tools;
 - creating digital coursework; incorporating digital tools, including digital environments and augmented reality;
 - collaborating with industry partners to create problem-solving hands-on projects;
 - instilling ethics in the course, among others.
- Innovations must have a demonstrable effect on enhancing student-learning outcomes.

Restrictions:

- Nomination process is confidential.

Submission requirements:

Dossiers must include all items in the following order:

- detailed Dean's letter of recommendation indicating
 - what the teaching innovation is
 - how it has benefited students or other faculty
 - how the innovation's impact has been assessed
- candidate's current CV
- external letters optional, but strongly encouraged
