




UB's Distinctive International Identity

- Among the most internationalized universities in the U.S.; leads SUNY and many AAU peers in this regard
 - For the past 20 years UB has ranked in the top 30 U.S. institutions enrolling the most international students
- UB has a large, rapidly growing international alumni network, with Alumni Association chapters in 12 countries
- UB maintains active partnerships with 100 leading universities in 30 countries
 - <u>UB's Singapore campus</u> is the largest operated by a U.S. institution in that country, delivering 7 UB degree programs and enrolling 1,500 students




VPIE Functional Areas

INTERNATIONAL STUDENT SERVICES (ISS)



- ISS provides immigration and support services to 6,700 international students, as well as their dependents
- Programs for inclusion and success
 - Transition/welcome programs for new students
 - Ongoing program of workshops, trips and cultural activities to promote student engagement and acculturation
 - Career readiness and professional development activities for international students
 - Optional and curricular practical training
 - Support for academic success and retention
 - International student emergency fund



EDUCATION AND STUDY ABROAD



- ~600 students participate in education abroad each year
 - 60+ UB programs in 30 countries; 1,000+ additional programs available through the SUNY consortium
 - Faculty-led programs offered in summer, winter and semester sessions
 - Exchanges with more than 30 leading universities around the world
 - First-Year Global Experience in winter session based on the UN Sustainable Development Goals—to be expanded in future years

On-campus partnership with

- Faculty and departments to develop new programs to meet needs of a given program or major
- UB Curriculum Office on the International Experience Track of the Global Pathway in the UB Curriculum
- Various units to address risk management

UB's International Partnerships



- Bilateral agreements with 100+ institutions in Africa, Asia, Australasia, Europe, Latin America, and the Middle East
- Offer variety of opportunities for collaboration and exchange for both faculty and students

UB's International Partnerships

- Some exchanges are based in departments or schools; others are university-wide
- Some agreements support research collaboration; others facilitate delivery of collaborative academic programs



International Academic Programs



- UB Singapore campus at Singapore Institute of Management (SIM)
 - Started in 2004
 - Business Administration, Communication, Psychology, Sociology, Economics, International Trade, and Geographic Information Science

FACULTY AND RESEARCH PROGRAMS

International Faculty Launch Program

- To provide advice, information, and encouragement for <u>new</u> <u>international TT faculty</u>, within a <u>confidential and</u> <u>positive atmosphere</u>
 - FL committees include department chair, 2 senior mentors (one from another dept), and convener
- Started in AY2021-22 and offered in departments in SEAS and CAS

Global and International Grant Program

- Seven grant opportunities
 - 6 for faculty, 1 for graduate students
- Including
 - Associate professor fund
 - Rapid grants
 - Manuscript preparation Workshop grant
 - Global research visiting scholar grant
 - External grant seed funding

UB Scholars at Risk Fellowship

- Launched in fall 2022
- Aims to
 - Provide humanitarian assistance to threatened scholars
 - Strengthen UB's mission with highly qualified academics who are a good fit for UB
- 1-year residential fellowships and remote options
- Partner with Scholars at Risk network and IIE Scholar Rescue Fund

Asia Research Institute (ARI)

- Inaugurated in spring 2023
- A premier multidisciplinary hub and collaborative space for research on Asia and Asia diaspora
- Flagship annual conference series, routable series on current Asia affairs, ARI undergraduate fellows program, lecture series, and international and SUNY partnership programs

COUNCIL ON INTERNATIONAL STUDIES AND PROGRAMS (CISP)

CISP

- Consultative committee advising Provost and Vice Provost on international education policies, programs, and initiatives
- Valuable sounding board for VPIE
- Membership includes 30 internationally active faculty from across UB
- Administrative staff from International Education offices, English Language Institute, Student Life, Academic Affairs and Alumni Engagement
