- The Elections Committee has reviewed several options, and proposed a new alternative to the Budget Advisory Committee, who have passed it up the Executive Committee for approval.
- The proposal is to purchase a license to SImplyVoting.com, at the price of \$4,800 for a 3 year subscription, with a 20% discount; i.e. ca. \$1,300 p.a. for three years. This software is used by many government and commercial agencies, including higher education institutions.

Discussion:

- Q/ Will senators need to register and will they need to provide additional details to this vendor?
 - o A/No.
- Q/ Was vetting done..?
 - A/ We were given a list of customer references, including SUNY Albany. Lexington Coop also uses this software.
- Q/ (What about other partners?)
 - o A/ The Faculty Senate is not interested in partnering with us at this time.
 - A/ We cannot partner with our UUP chapter because they fall outside of UB's state funding boundary. Also they have found their own solution centrally.
- Motion to purchase the SImplyVoting software for a 3-year license for the amount described: Janiece Jankowski (RJ Multari). Passed unanimously.
