- Budget Advisory Committee: Has met and reviewed funds for the year. At this moment, there is \$26,583 available for use by the PSS. Monies have been carried over from previous years due to the pandemic. (see detailed slides). Two budget requests need to be approved by the EC:
 - Support for a kick-off luncheon for Department of Indigenous Studies: \$2000. Monies will be used to assist with event, PSS is not the only sponsor.
