UNFINISHED BUSINESS

Request for comments, questions, motions on the following:

- Faculty Senate moving ahead with resolution for campus reforestation/aforestation.
- Tree Drone Inventory: Prof. Le Wang from Geography moving ahead with pilot research; increasing support by UB admin.
- Possibility of a new employee fund for reforestation (\$5000 threshold) as part of faculty-staff campaign, if met will be promoted actively), possibility of matching money. Funds will be used to plant new trees, not to maintain existing trees. Possibility that PSS could contribute money and plant the first tree. More conversations to come.
- Consensual Relationship Policy draft, previously shared with EC no new comments made
- SUNY University Faculty Senate election will be held soon to replace senator who has left plus an alternate; UB Faculty Senate will hold the election, but likely use our system. Both faculty and professional staff are eligible.
- Shared Governance staffing welcome Gail Reino, temporary replacement for Lindsay, funded by Provost's office.

- Tim had conversation with Scot Weber about reducing campus fees for meetings; no relief offered but a conversation is occurring on Capen 5th floor. (Did fund our temp staffer.)
 - Kelly Cruttenden offered to provide free meeting space in Athletics.
- Special Committee on Redistricting draft survey questions previously shared with EC.
 - Comments:
 - Affiliation: allow "check all that apply".
 - Affiliation: add "active participant/not formally involved".
 - Add number of meetings attended per year.
 - Make first question an introduction and learning opportunity: are you aware that as an employee... you are a member of the PSS; are you aware that you have a senator who represents you on that senate...
 - What is the goal of the survey? To assess need for redistricting, understand how people see themselves represented on campus.
 - Link to information about the current areas.
 - How do you want PSS to communicate with you..? (Countered this touches on marketing, which will be addressed this spring.)
 - Add open ended question about how PSS is structured.
- Climate Survey findings –considering inviting Despina for a deeper conversation possibly in January, encourages each committee and senators in general to raise questions and concerns.

NEW BUSINESS

- PSS Listserves (shared summary details on current Lists) plus comments by Pam Rose of Professional Staff Connect List. We currently have many listserves, encouraging deeper conversation about which we really need especially for the professionalstaffconnect-list. Future topic for EC.
- Buffalo 25 new presidential push: what can PSS do to help; admin has a short list of proposed markers (categories) for improvement; PSS could have our own push (Drive for 25?).
 - Need to share our ideas so we don't surprise anyone?
 - Was shared with Scot Weber and he loved the idea.
 - Opportunity to show our value as professionals, that we're excited, acting positively.
 - Theme sounds nice but will be tricky to attain any significant changes by 2025. We can only begin the process, possibly complete projects already begun.
 - Great opportunity to engage with senators and constituents to identify growth areas; e.g. smoke free campus, financial diversity, diversity...
 - We need criteria of these standings and where we rank.

- Budget Advisory Cmt membership too constrictive:
 - Chair can be current or former EC member or designee approved by EC.

 - o Comments:
 - Does it have to go to Bylaws? No, just in standing rules.
 - Dome urged caution with changes since so important to PSS.
 - Chair will share with EC at next meeting for more consideration.
